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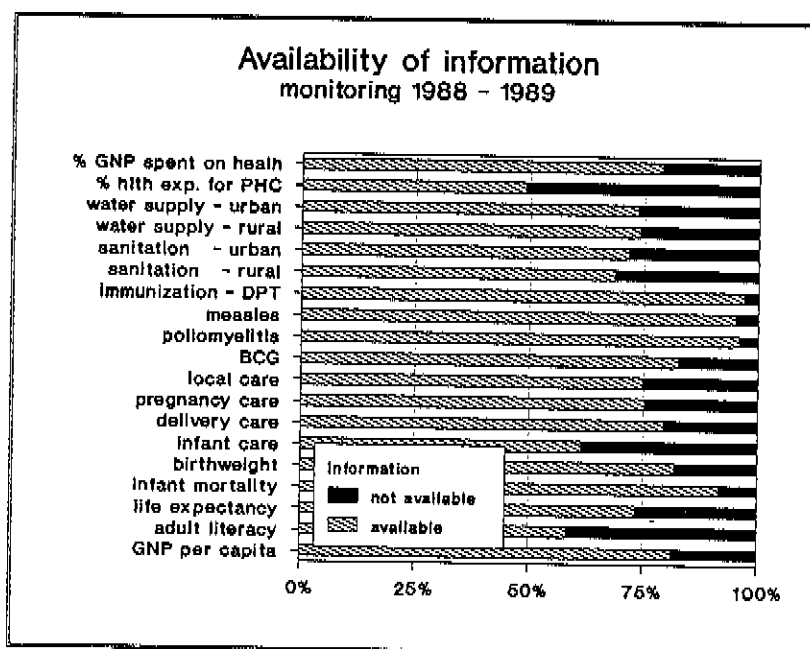

Detailed analysis of global indicators

Explanatory note

In May 1989, the World Health Assembly examined the second report on monitoring progress in implementing the strategies for health for all. This report contained a brief analysis of the global indicators based on information provided by Member States.

The purpose of this document is to present a more detailed analysis of the global indicators. It is composed of two sections and an annex.

Data provided by countries are presented according to WHO regions and by level of development. For the latter the United Nations classification has been used (updated December 1988). Most of the relevant population figures used in this document have been provided by the Population Division of the Department of International Economic and Social Affairs of the United Nations. The data on infants surviving at age one are those used by the Expanded Programme on Immunization.

Section I

The analysis of the global indicators is presented here. For each indicator the following tables are presented:

- a) The results of the data collected, the number of countries reporting and the relevant population they represent.
- b) Either the weighted average of the indicator value or, in the case of coverage indicators, the estimated number of the population covered and not covered, by WHO region and by level of development.
- c) Whenever possible the five countries with the largest number of persons not covered, not immunized etc. and the percentage each country represents in relation to the total number of persons not covered in the world, as reported by countries.
- d) The distribution of countries according to the categories defined for each indicator.
- e) The percentage distribution of the population for the categories retained above.
- f) A comparison between the data of the 1988 monitoring and the 1985 evaluation. The data used for 1985 are those reported in document WHO/HST/87.2.

Some figures illustrate the results presented in this section.

Section II

This section consists of five sets of tables presenting the data provided by countries for each indicator together with the reference period. Countries are grouped by WHO region.

Annex

The annex consists of 2 tables indicating population figures used for weighting and estimates.

The first table indicates population by place of residence and sex, the second indicates estimates of newborns and population aged 15 years and more, by sex.

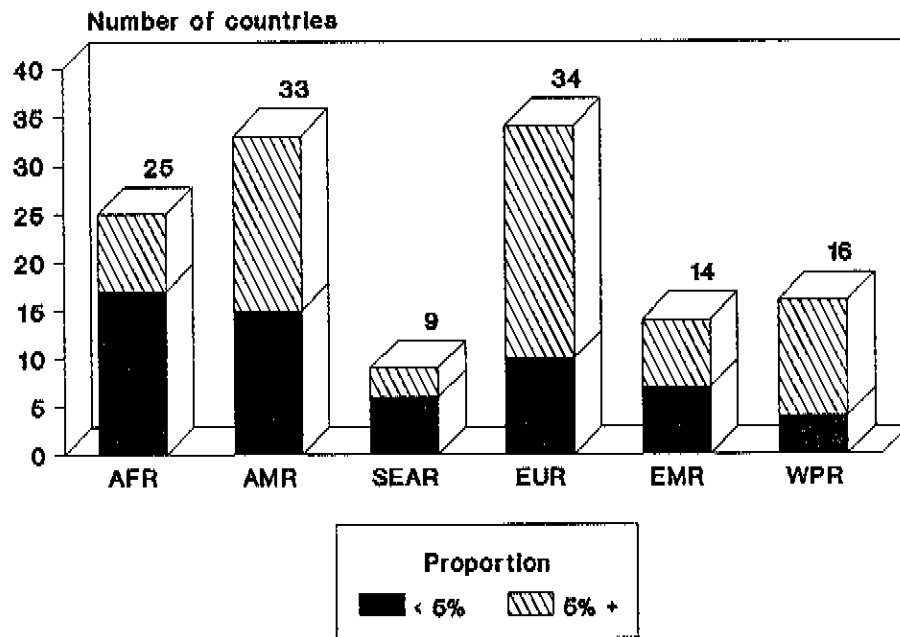

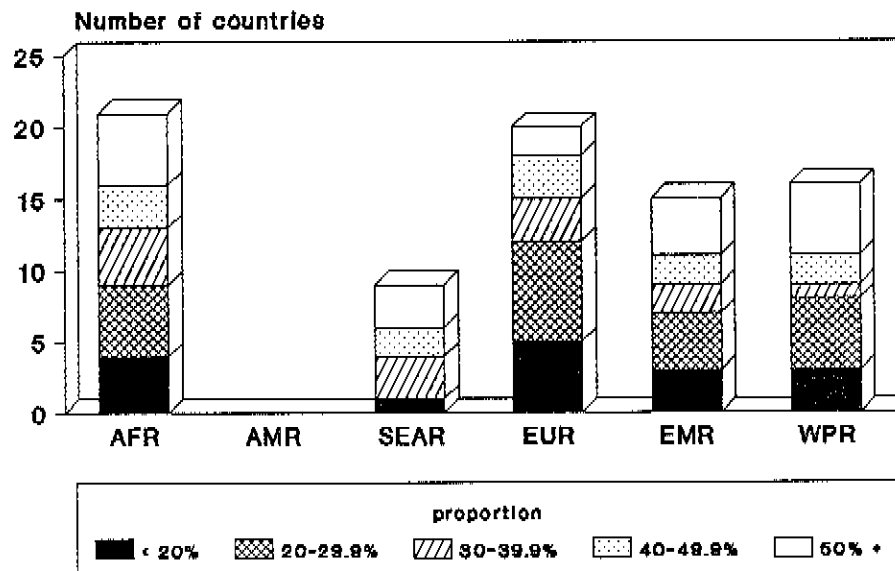

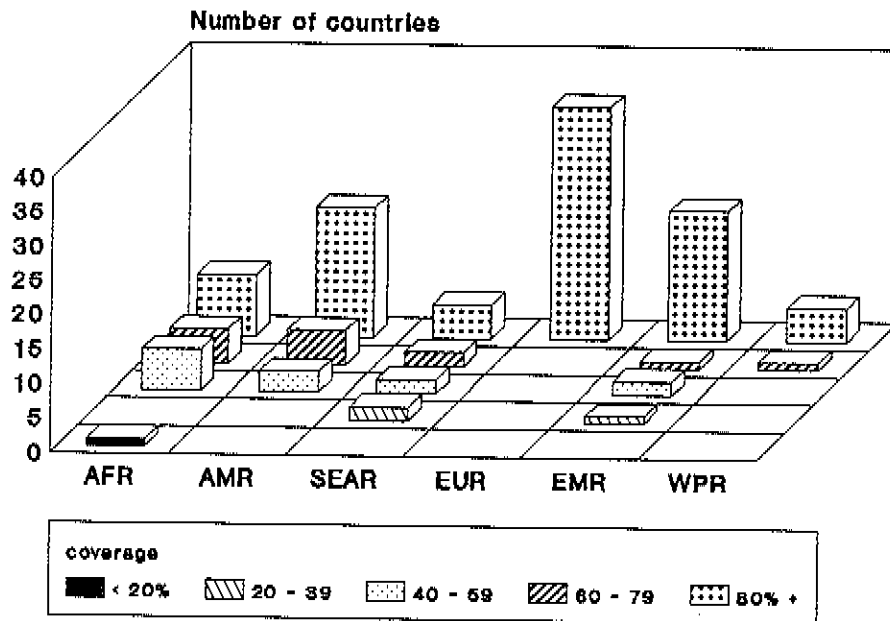

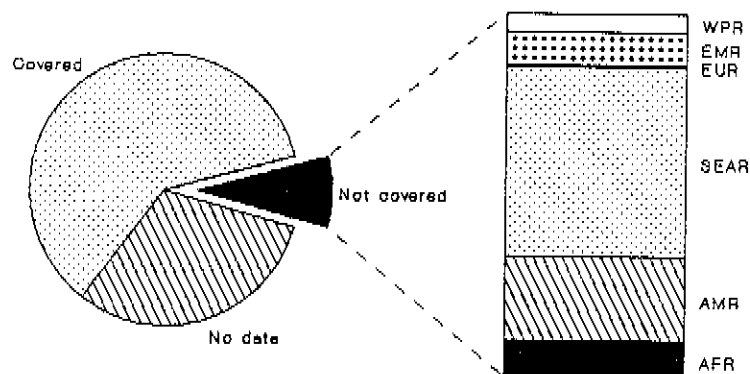

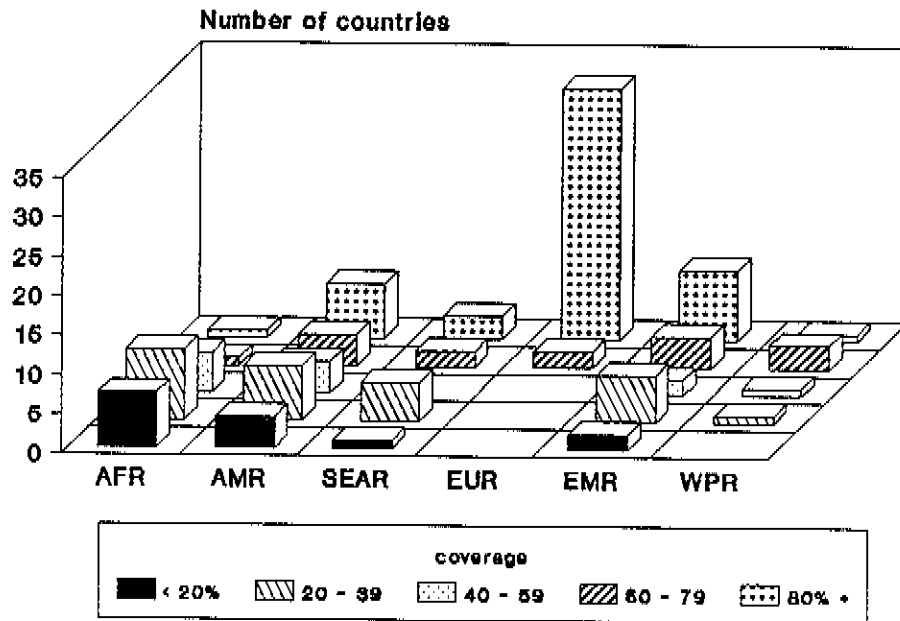

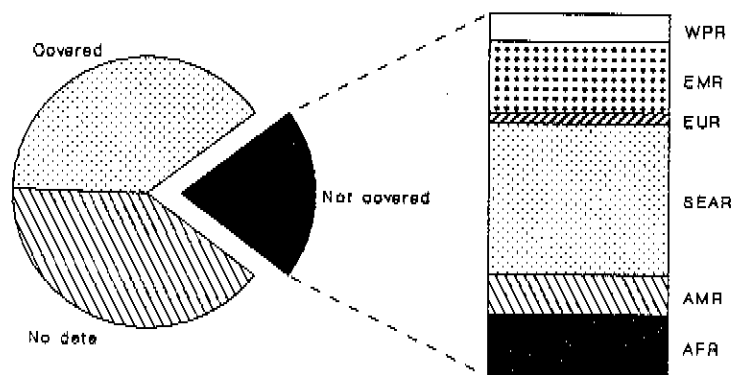

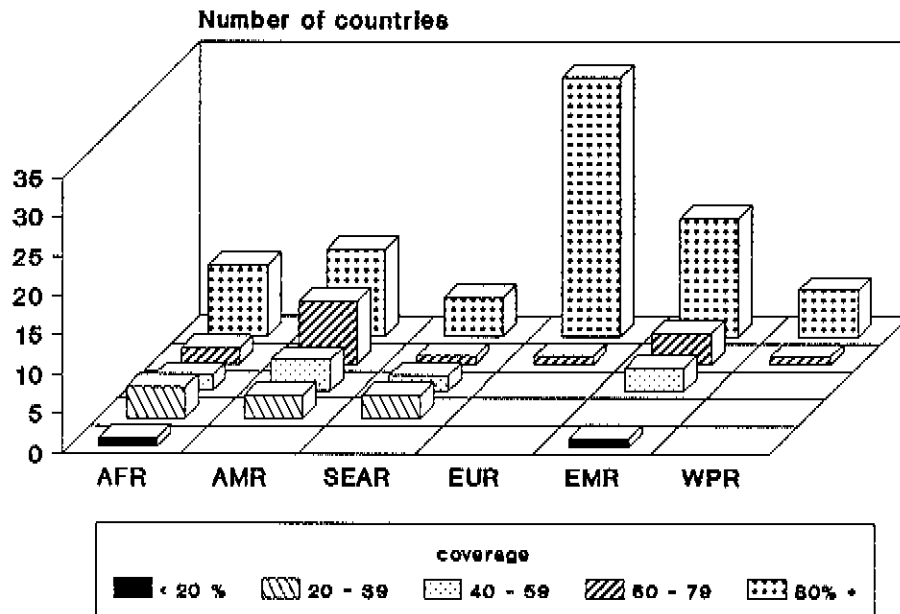

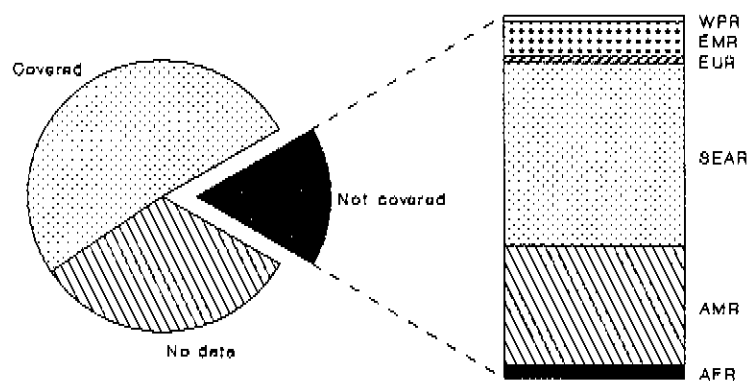

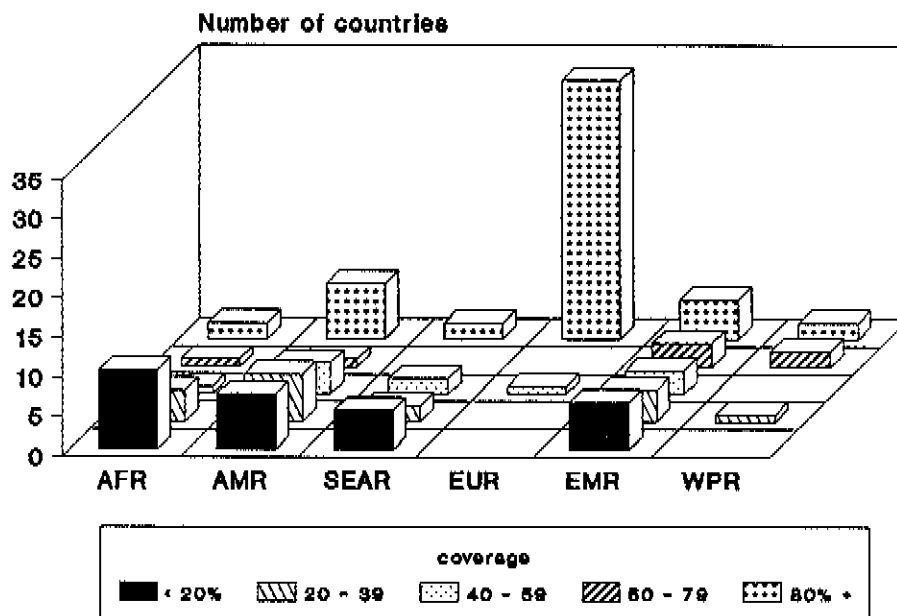

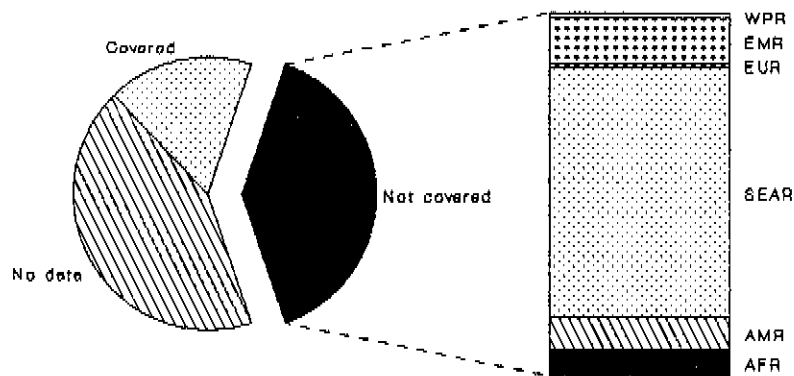

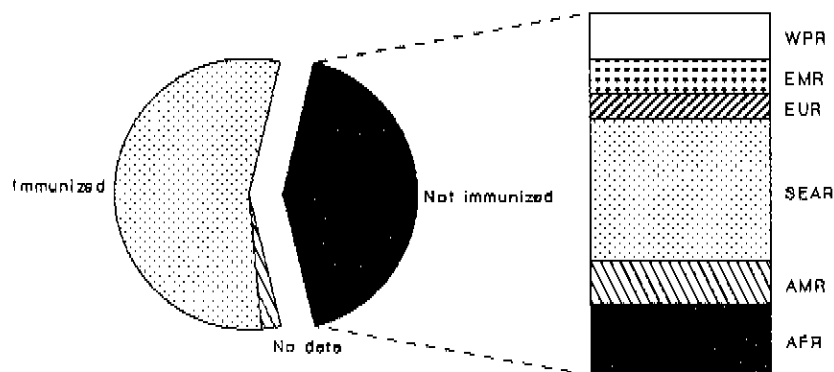

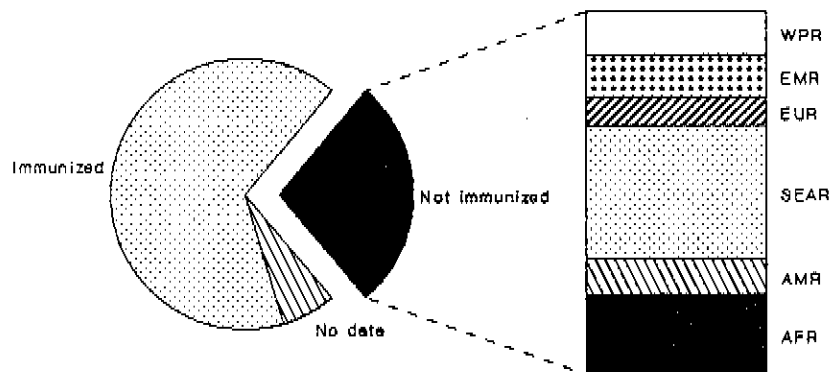

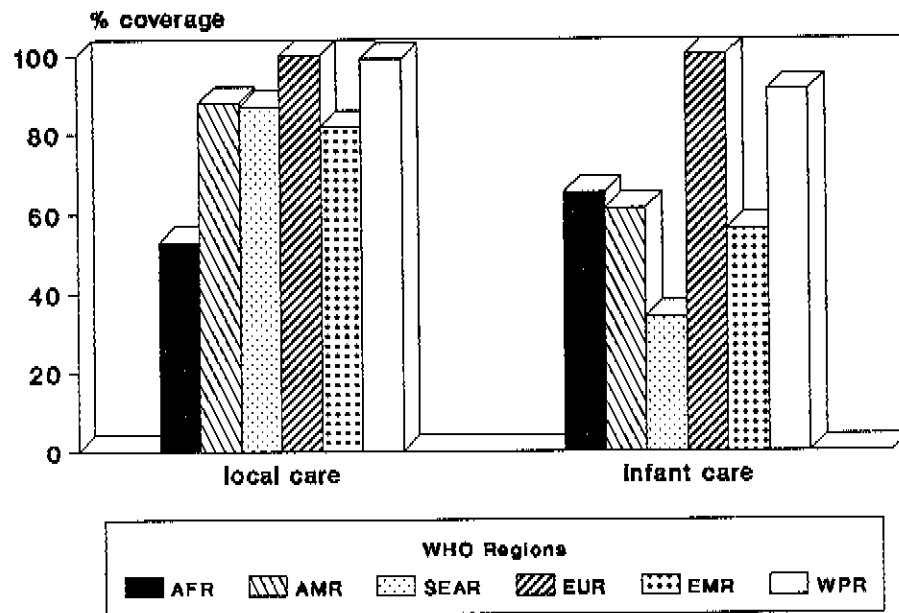

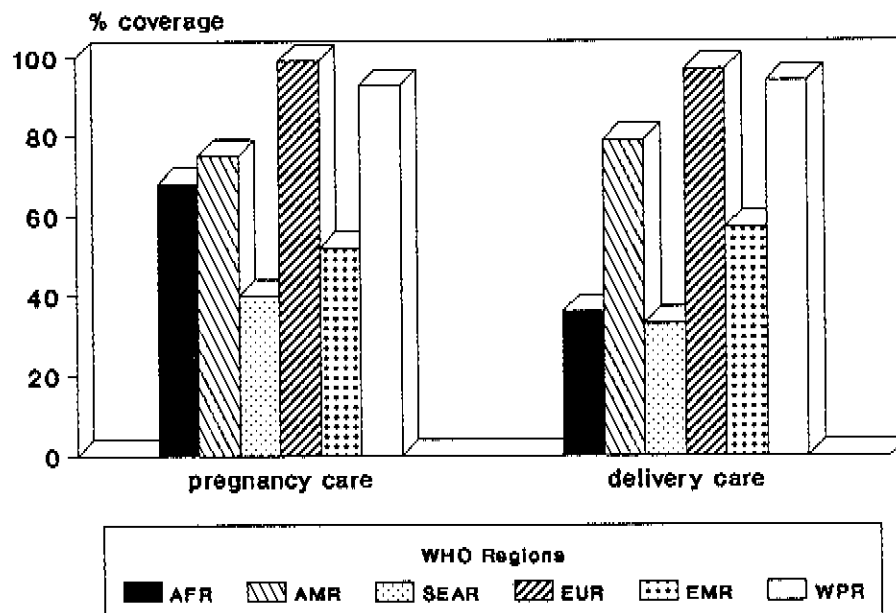

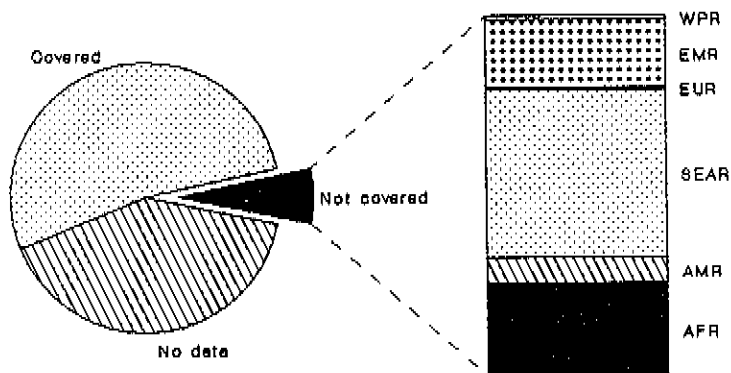

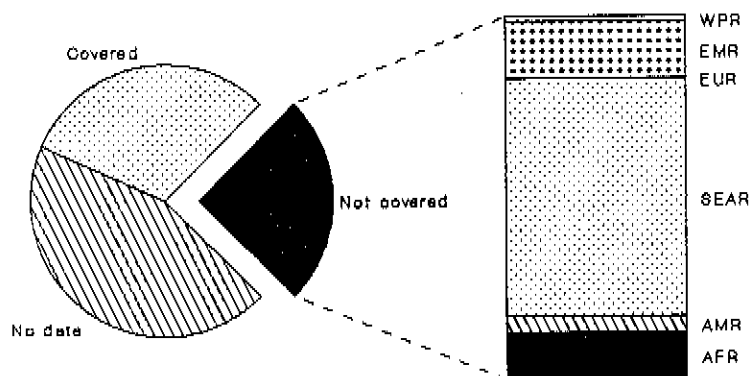

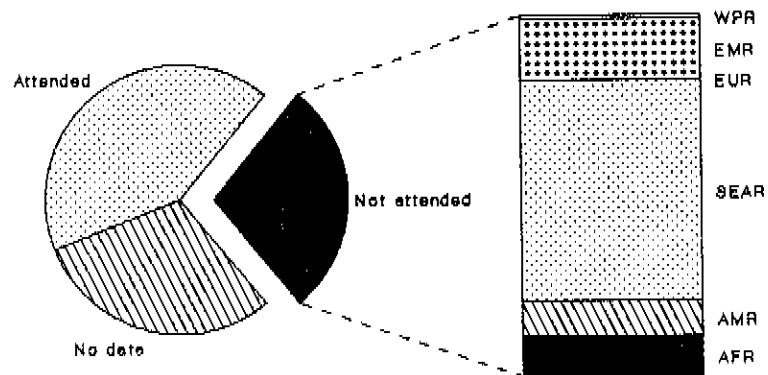

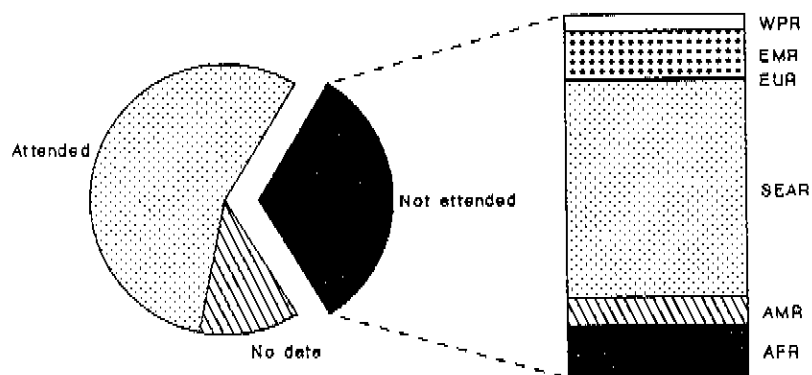

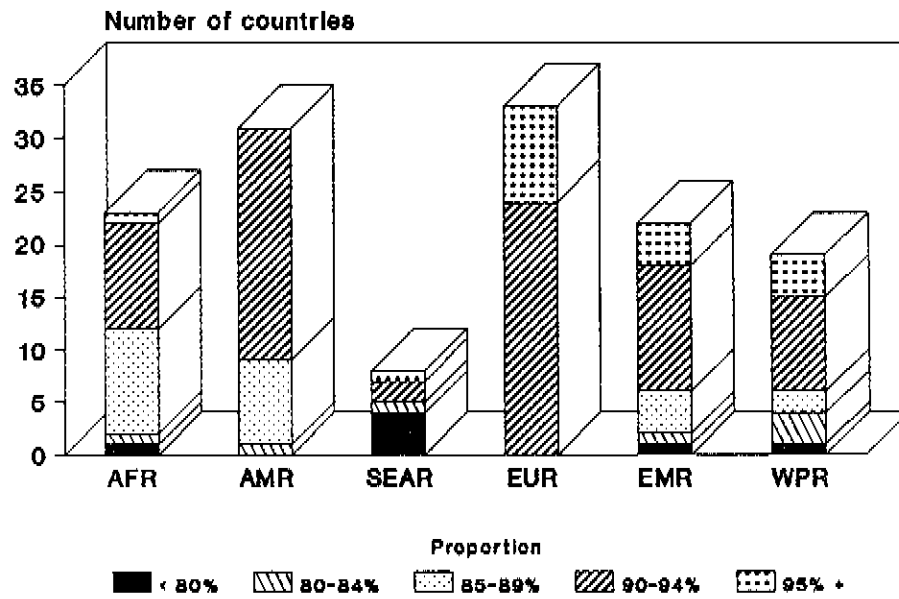

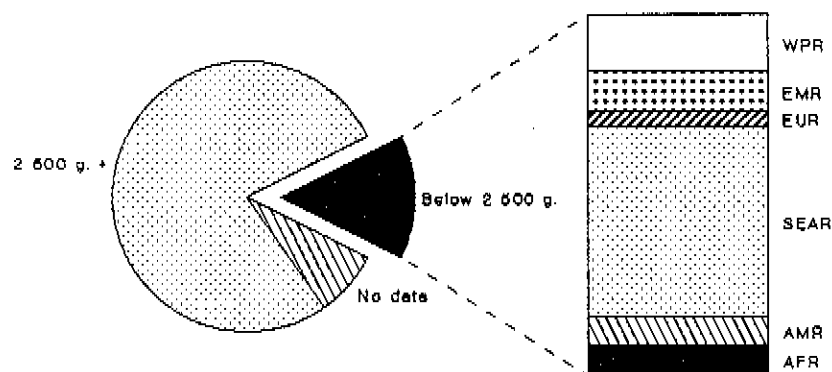

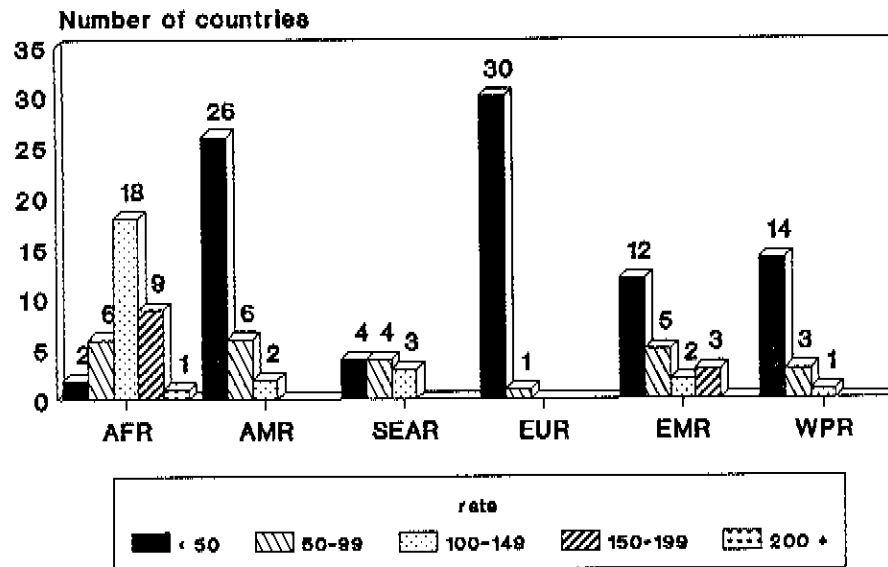

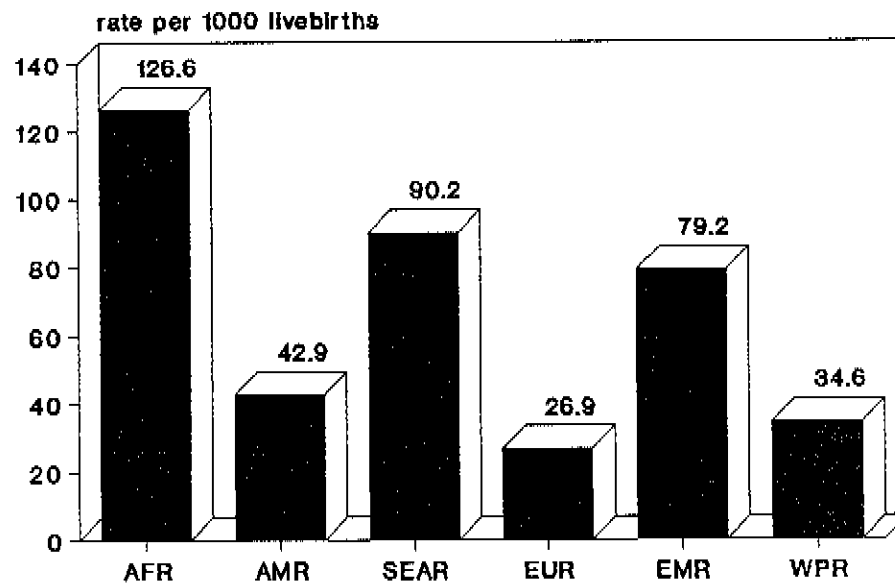

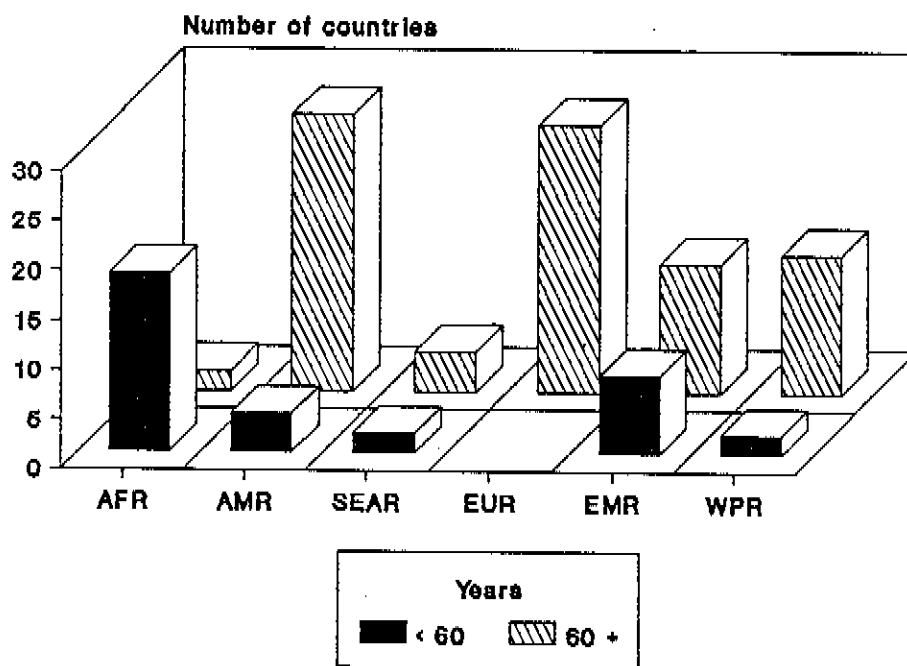

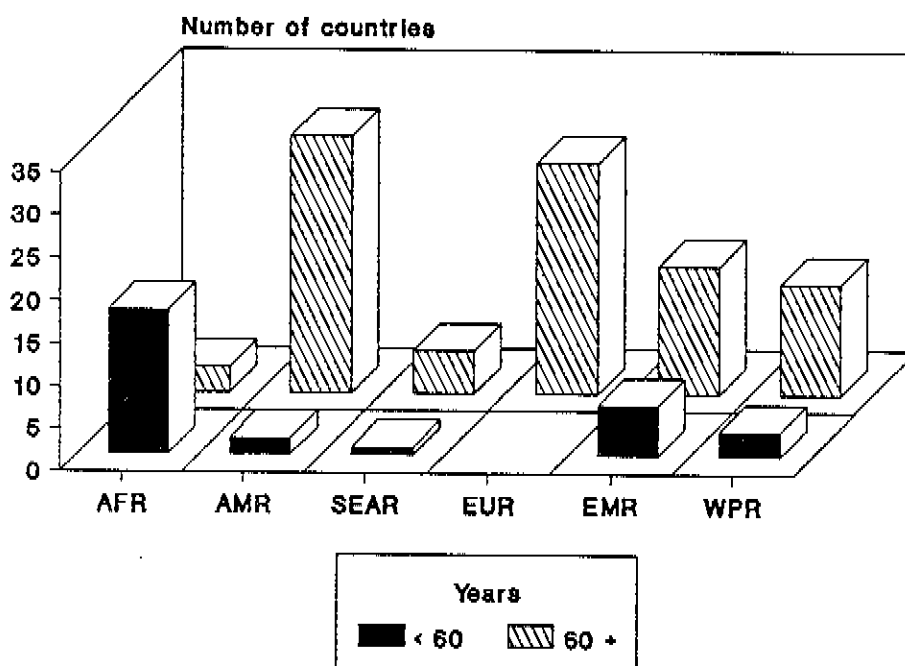

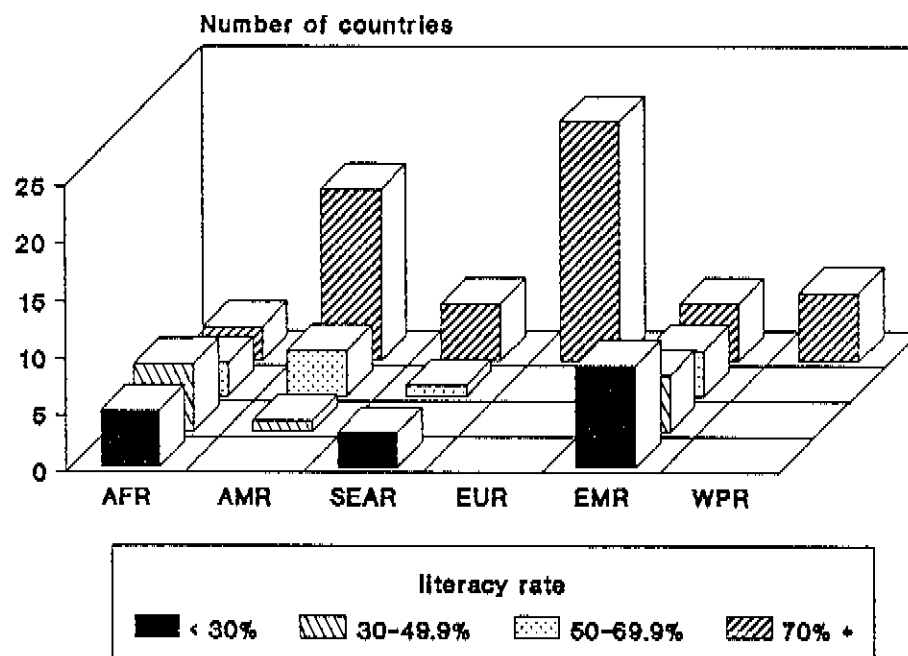

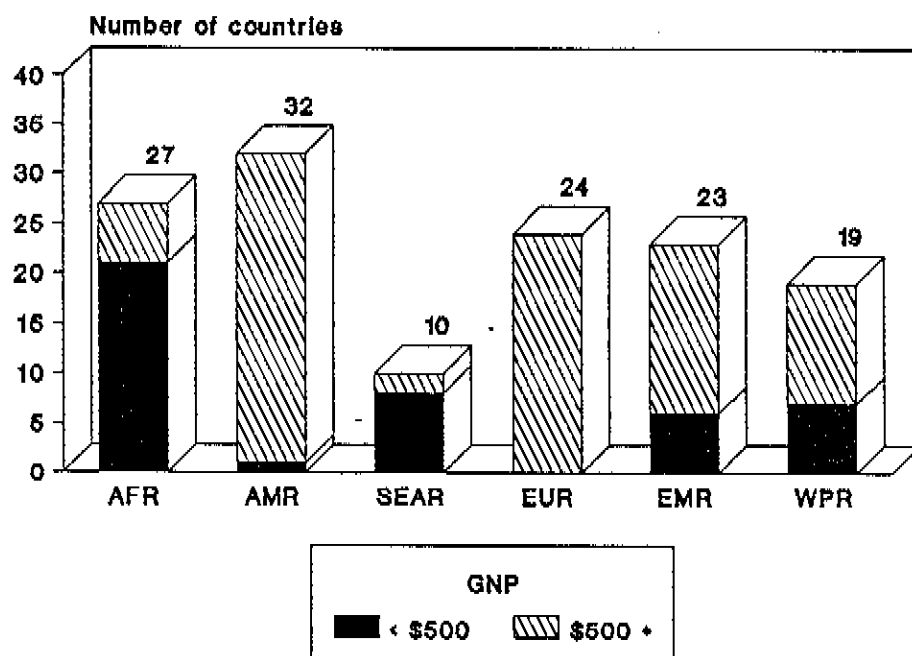
