On behalf of the Government and the people of Nauru, I have the honour to inform you that Nauru wishes to submit an application for admission to the membership of the World Health Organization in accordance with Chapter III, Article 6 of the WHO Constitution.

Nauru achieved Independence on the 31 January 1968, proclaimed its Sovereignty as a political and economical sustainable country. It is responsible for its own destiny, conducts its own affairs, internal and external, memberships with many international and regional organizations with diplomatic relationships with several countries.

As part of this application, a background paper is attached.

I shall be grateful if Nauru's application could be submitted by you Sir, and be placed on the Agenda for consideration at the next World Health Assembly in May 1994 in Geneva, Switzerland.
