*All manufacturers included in the previous revision have been contacted and invited to revise and update their information. In addition, attempts have been made to identify new manufacturers not previously listed.*

*The category headings are based on common usage, not taxonomy. The miscellaneous section includes listings for 2 specific immunoglobulin and 20 miscellaneous microbial antigen vaccines.*

*Specific immunoglobulins are listed under the appropriate disease heading or in the miscellaneous section if the disease has no separate entry. Suppliers of normal human immunoglobulins are listed in a separate section. Other blood products are not listed.*

*The list does not claim completeness, but nevertheless hopes to provide some useful information. It needs to be stressed, however, that the World Health Organization cannot accept responsibility for the accuracy of the information, nor does the inclusion of products in this list mean that they are endorsed or recommended in any way by WHO.*

*Pages have been numbered according to their section. A feature of this revision is the loose-leaf format, with sections separated by tabs. It is expected that revisions will be made annually.*
