



Figure 1: Global annual reported polio cases, 1988-1996

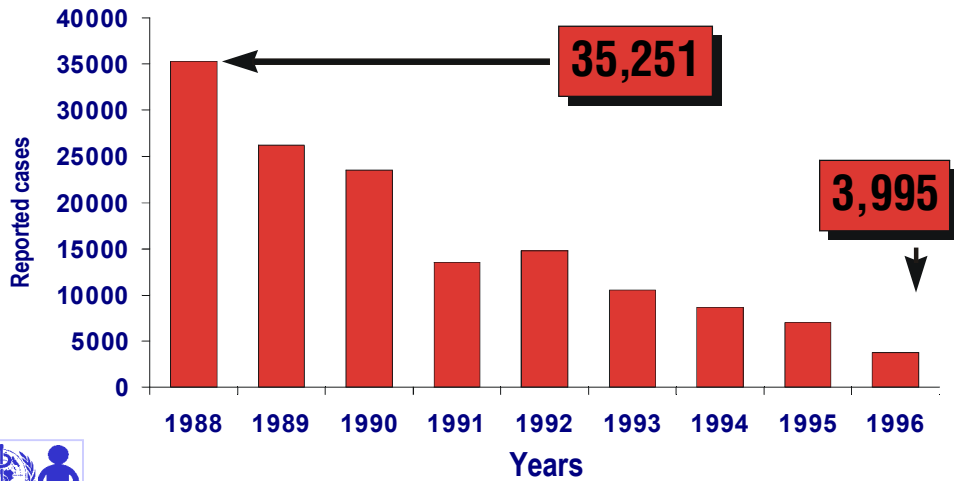
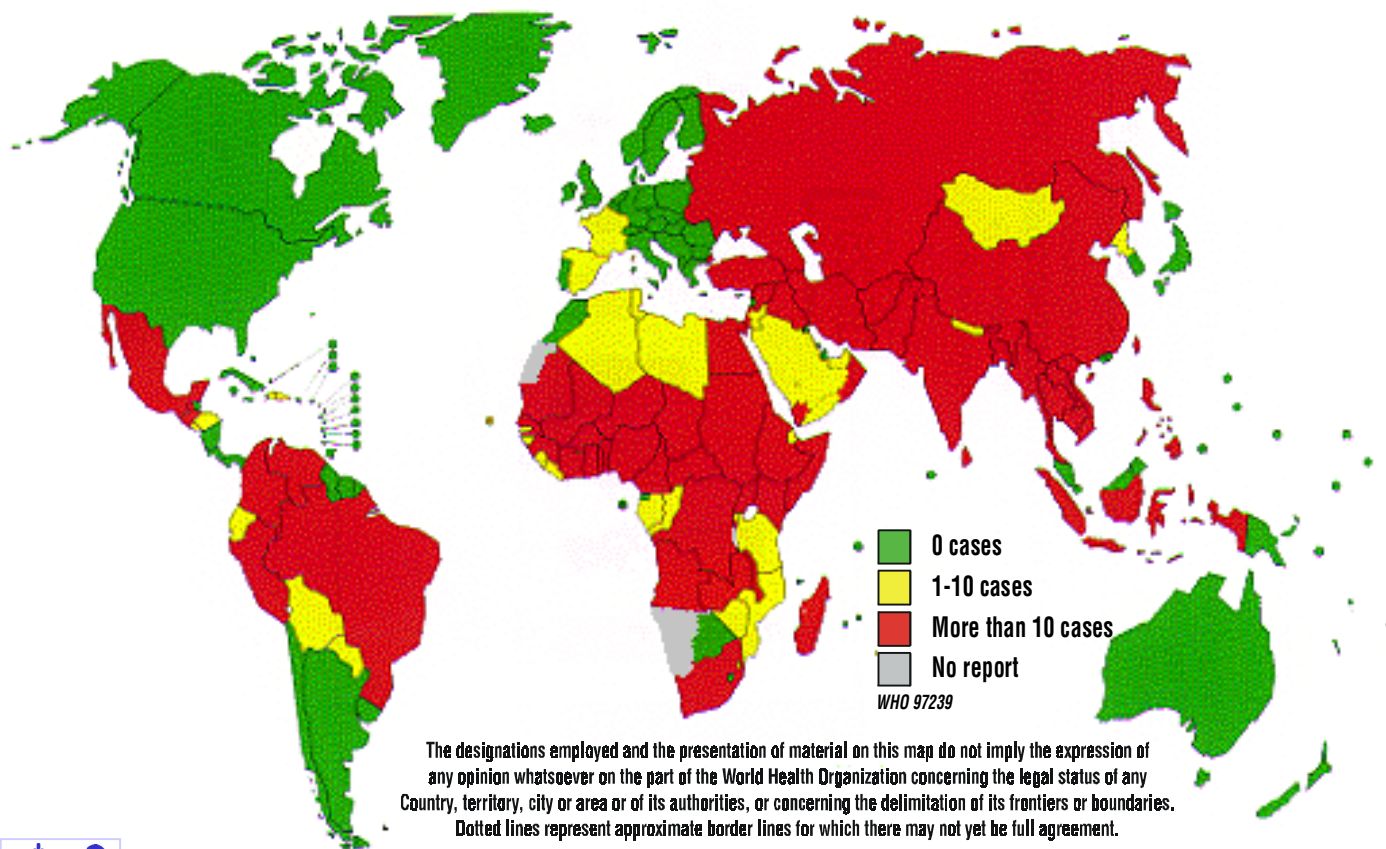


Figure 2: Global incidence of indigenous polio, 1988: 35,251 polio cases reported

1996: 3995 cases reported**

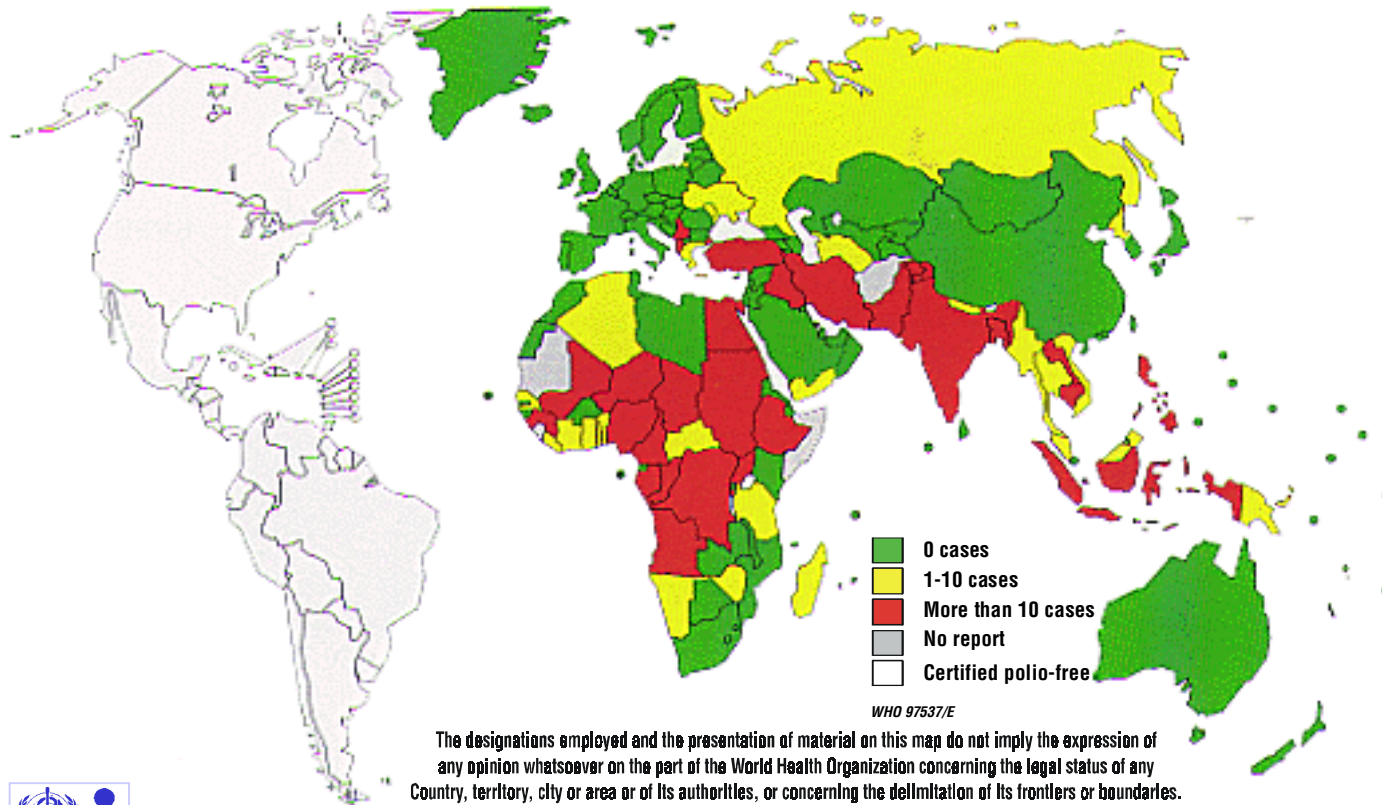
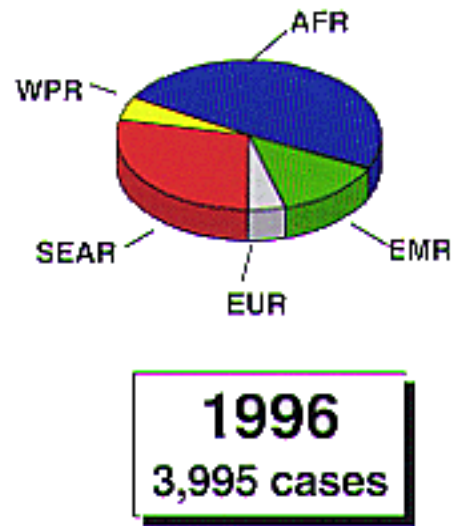
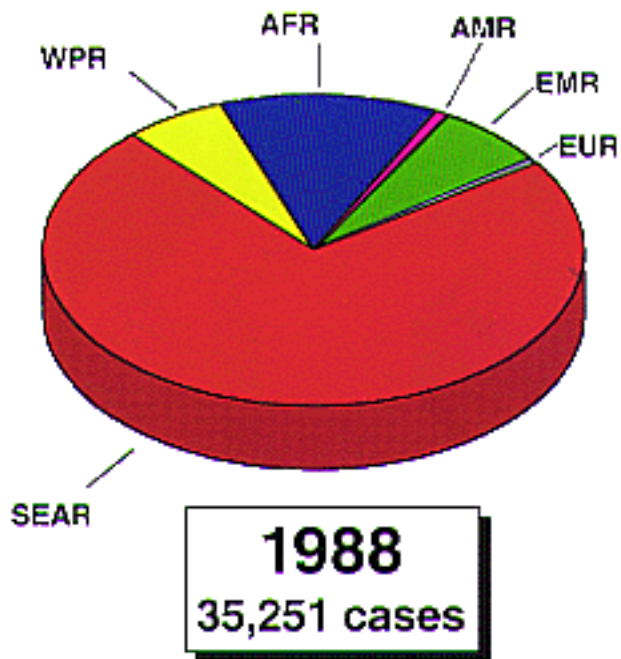


Figure 4: Proportion of reported polio cases by WHO Region, 1988 and 1996

Figure 5: Countries conducting national immunization days (NIDs)

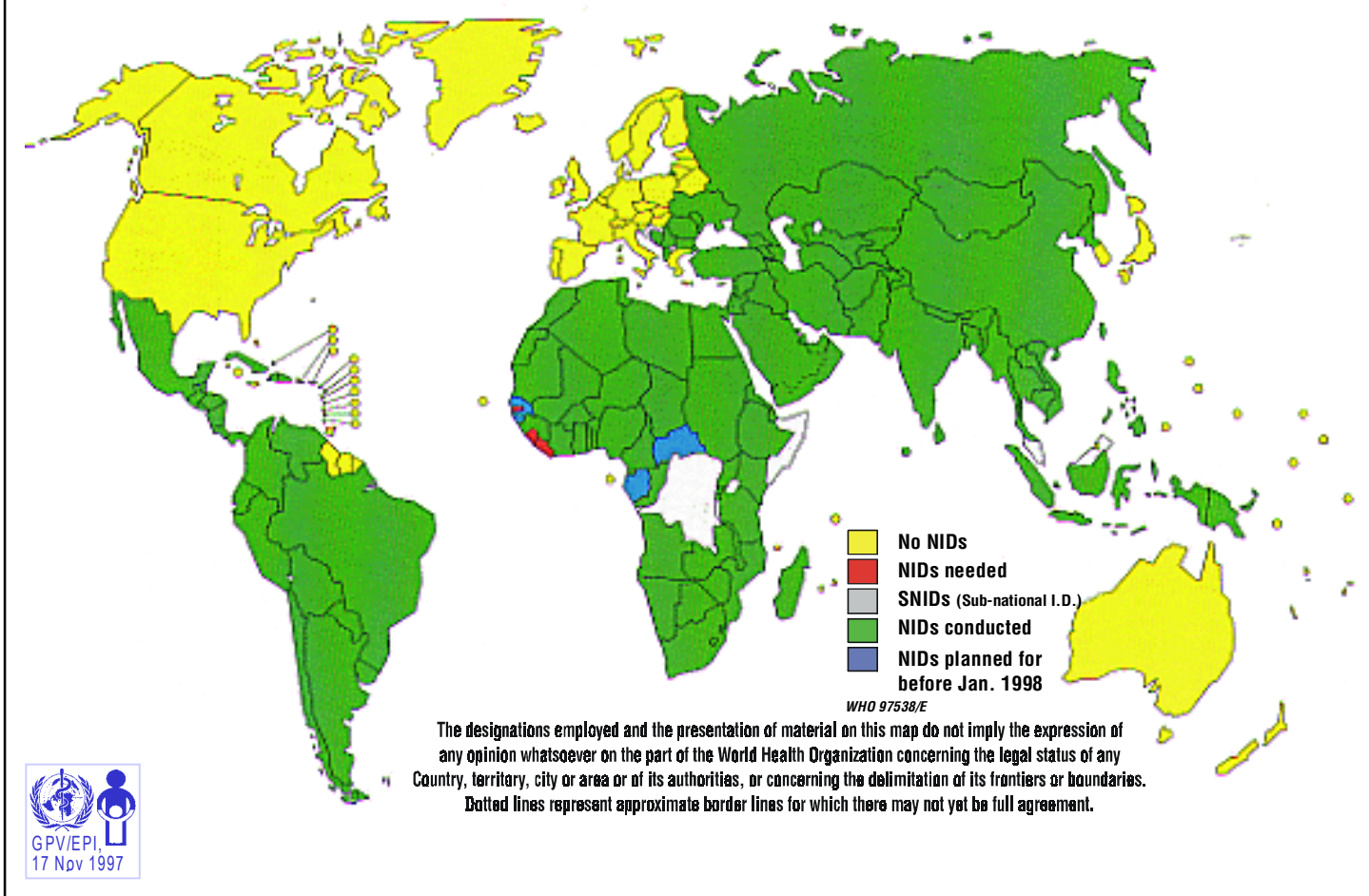
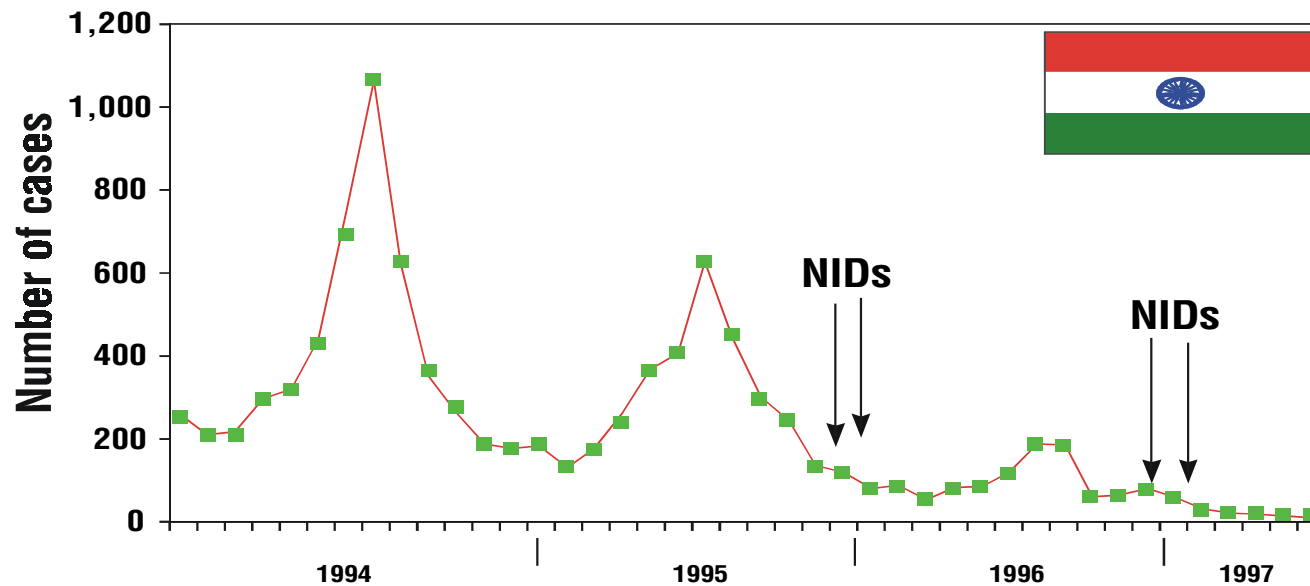


Figure 6: Reported cases of paralytic poliomyelitis by month, India, January 1994 - June 1997*

Figure 7: EPI coverage during polio eradication—countries in the Western Pacific Region conducting national immunization days, 1990-1995

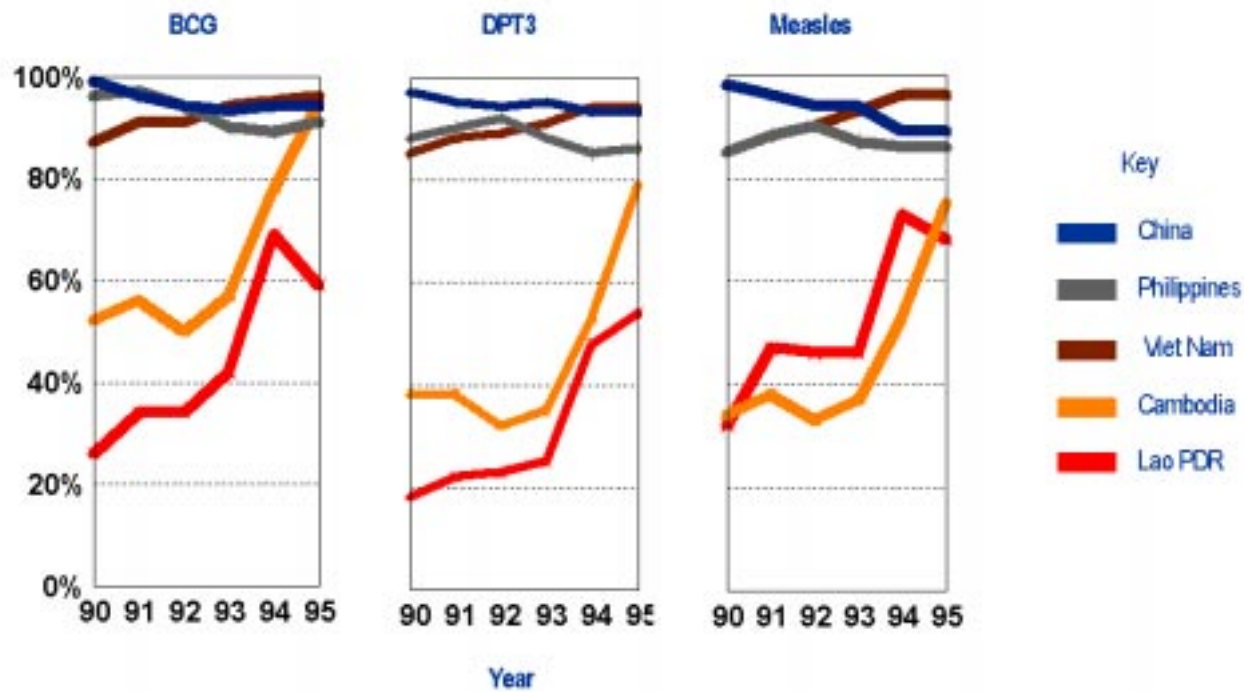


Figure 8: Polio-endemic areas affected by conflict
