INFORMATION CIRCULAR

1. Location

The Interregional Seminar on CHP will be held at the Hotel President, Babin-Kuk, Dubrovnik, Yugoslavia, from 11 to 17 November, 1979.

2. Opening Ceremony

The opening ceremony will be held on Sunday, 11 November, at 18.00 hrs at the Hotel President. Participants are advised to endeavour to arrive in time for the official opening of the Seminar

3. Climate

Dubrovnik has a Mediterranean climate with mean temperatures of 12°C (45°F) in January and about 26°C (79°F) in July. At the time of the meeting the weather can be fine during the day, but evenings are cold.

4. Hotel accommodation

Hotel accommodation has been arranged for all participants at the Hotel President where the meeting will be held. Attached is a form to be completed and returned to WHO Headquarters, CHP, 1211 Geneva, Switzerland, not later than 28 October 1979, in order to inform the Hotel accordingly.

5. Working languages

6. Subsistence allowance

All participants will receive subsistence allowance for the duration of the Seminar (US\$ 45.-- per day).

7. Travel arrangements

Participants are advised to finalize their travel plans as soon as possible and inform Dr C. Vukmanovic, MPP/CHP, WHO, 1211 Geneva 27, Switzerland by returning the attached form. The arrivals can be confirmed by cabling to the address given below on point 14 in order that arrangements can be made for transportation to the hotel.

Participants are strongly advised to make their return flight reservations before leaving their own countries. A representative of a travel agency will be available at the Hotel President to assist with the confirmation of your reservations.



8. Entry visa

Participants are advised to ensure that their passports and visas are valid for the host country and the countries of transit. Most nationals do not need a visa for entry into Yugoslavia. However, you should consult the nearest Yugoslav Consulate or Embassy on this.

9. Vaccination requirements

10. Insurance and excess baggage

Participants should note that WHO cannot be held liable or responsible for any claim arising out of death, injury, sickness or other disability. Similarly, participants are responsible for any charges for excess baggage or for baggage insurance. Likewise, taxi fares to and from airports, airport taxes, service charges for porters and tips, passport and visa fees are not reimbursable by the Organization.

11. Currency

The unit of currency is the new Dinar (ND) which is divided into 100 paras. Coins are issued in denominations of 5, 10, 20 and 50 paras and 1, 2, 5 and 10 dinars. Notes are issued in denominations of 10, 20, 50, 100, 500 and 1000 dinars.

The current rate of exchange is approximately 18,5 dinars to US\$ 1, but is subject to fluctuations.

12. Exchange controls

There is no limitation to the amount of foreign currency which travellers may bring into the country, provided that, upon request, the amount is declared to the customs officers.

13. Customs

Personal effects may be brought into Yugoslavia duty-free including:

- a) 200 cigarettes, or 50 cigars, or 25 grams of tobacco;
- b) 1 litre of wine and 1 litre of spirits.
