LA PESTE EN 1958

La baisse de la fréquence de la peste au cours des années récentes a continué en 1958 où le nombre des cas enregistrés officiellement a été le plus faible depuis le début du siècle. 213 cas seulement ont été relevés dans le monde, dont 26 dans l'Inde, contre 569 (et 47 dans l'Inde) en 1957 et 15 399 en 1951 (dont 8 230 dans l'Inde).

La répartition des cas (voir carte) a été la suivante:

Sur le continent africain, six cas seulement ont été signalés dans la partie nord-est du Congo belge et 19 cas dans la province centrale du Kenya. A Madagascar, 21 cas sporadiques ont été signalés dans plusieurs circonscriptions situées pour la plupart dans la province de Tananarive.

En Amérique, les foyers actifs ont été situés en Equateur (provinces de Loja et Chimborazo), au Pérou (Departamentos de Piura, Lambayeque, Ancash et Cajamarca) et dans plusieurs circonscriptions de l'Etat de Bahia au Brésil.

En Asie (en dehors de la Chine continentale et de l'U.R.S.S.) un nouveau foyer a été découvert dans la région de Kourdistan-Miandoab en Iran. Les 26 cas signalés dans l'Inde ont été enregistrés dans trois districts de la partie sud du pays. Tous les cas signalés en Birmanie se sont produits dans des villes: douze à Bassein¹, un à Rangoun¹ et cinq à Meiktila. Au Vietnam dix cas ont été signalés dans une région de la province de Tanan, quatre dans la province de Baria et un à Saigon¹.

PLAGUE IN 1958

The downward trend of plague incidence observed during recent years continued in 1958 when the number of officially recorded cases was the lowest since the beginning of the present century. Only 213 cases were officially recorded throughout the world, of which 26 were in India, as compared with 569 (and 47 in India) in 1957 and 15 399 in 1951 (of which 8230 were in India).

The distribution of cases in 1958 (see map) was as follows:

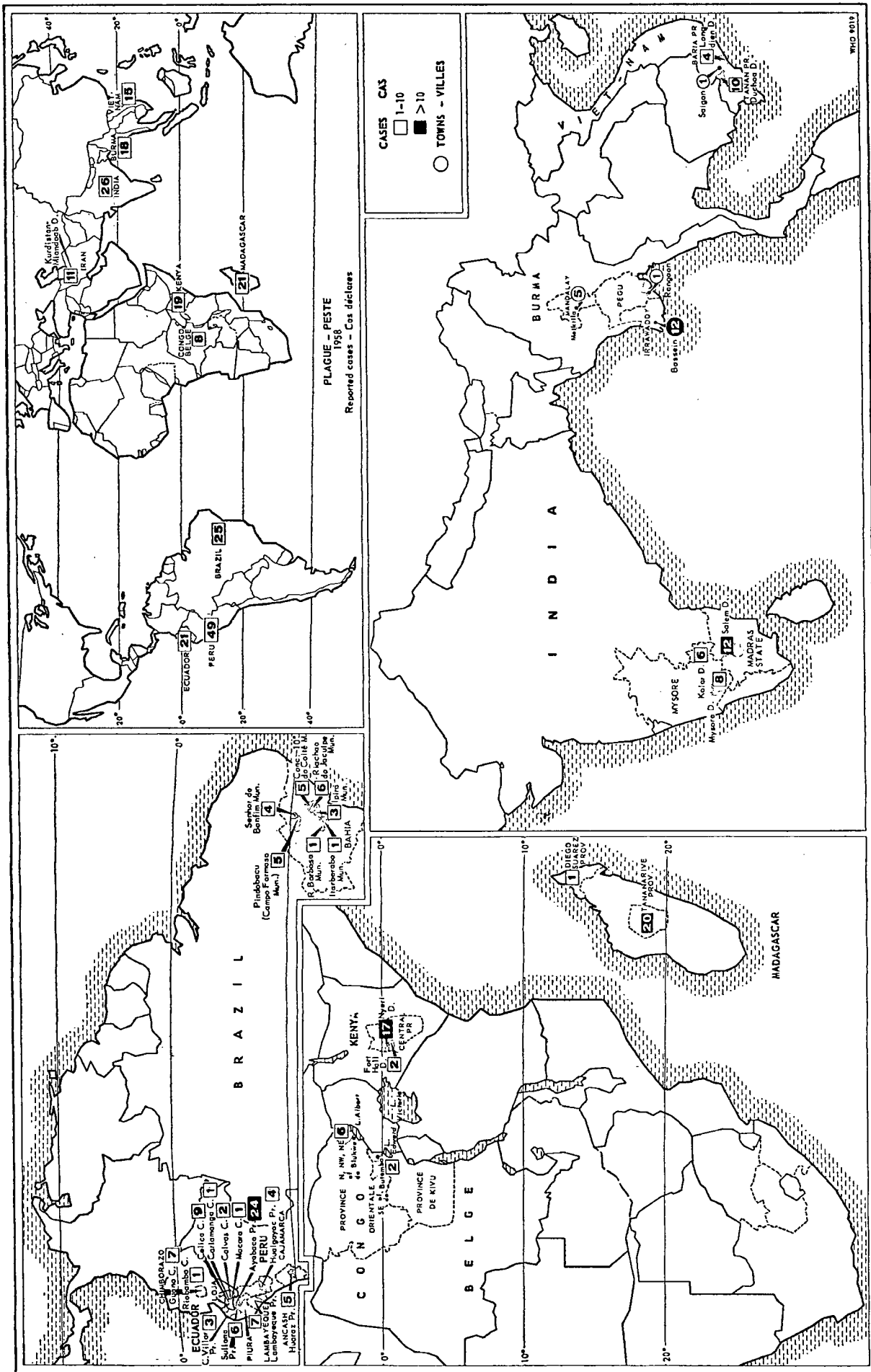
In continental Africa only six cases were reported in the north-eastern part of Belgian Congo and 19 cases in the Central Province of Kenya. In Madagascar 21 sporadic cases were recorded in several local areas most of which were situated in the Tananarive Province.

In America, active foci were located in Ecuador (Loja and Chimborazo Provinces), in Peru (Piura, Lambayeque, Ancash and Cajamarca Departments) and in a number of local areas of the State of Bahia in Brazil.

In Asia (outside continental China and USSR) a new foci (11 cases) was discovered in the Kurdistan-Miandoab area of Iran. The 26 cases reported in India were observed in three districts in the southern part of the country. All cases reported in Burma occurred in urban areas: twelve in Bassein¹, one in Rangoon¹ and five in Meiktila. In Viet-Nam ten cases were reported in one area of the Tanan Province, four in the Baria Province and one case in Saigon¹.
