INFORMATIONS ÉPIDÉMIOLOGIQUES — EPIDEMIOLOGICAL NOTES

GRIPPE

Amérique

Canada. Plusieurs poussées d'affections respiratoires aiguës ont été signalées dans l'Alberta, en Colombie britannique, dans les Territoires du Nord-Ouest et à Terre-Neuve, puis dans l'île du Prince-Edouard, au cours du mois de janvier.

Asie

Des épidémies localisées de grippe sont signalées dans diverses parties de l'Inde. Les recherches faites ont conduit dans tous les cas, sauf un seul, à incriminer des virus A/Asie comme agents responsables.

Europe

L'incidence des affections aiguës de type grippal s'est accrue brusquement au cours de la seconde semaine de janvier en Suisse. Les poussées épidémiques les plus marquées se situent dans les cantons de Zurich, Schwyz, Bâle (ville et campagne), Grisons, Tessin, Neuchâtel et Genève. En France des poussées épidémiques d'affections analogues, d'abord localisées (seconde quinzaine de janvier) se sont étendues à l'ensemble du territoire. Elles demeurent bénignes. Les agents infectieux en cause sont en cours d'étude; il s'agit du virus de type B à Paris, ainsi que dans l'Ouest, le centre et l'Est du pays. Au Danemark, les deux dernières semaines ont été marquées par une augmentation de l'incidence des affections d'allure grippale chez les enfants des écoles. Le tableau clinique est bénin; pas d'extension de la maladie aux adultes; les examens sérologiques pratiqués jusqu'à présent sont caractéristiques d'une grippe de type B. Aux Pays-Bas* la grippe B s'est étendue considérablement; elle affecte surtout les enfants. Les pneumonies sont très rares; cependant l'on signale quelques décès dus à des pneumonies à staphylocoques.

*Royaume-Uni.** En Angleterre et au Pays de Galles, le nombre des notifications de pneumonie et des décès attribuable à la grippe s'est accru brusquement au cours de la semaine dernière et l'ensemble du pays peut être considéré comme atteint. Des souches A appartenant apparemment au groupe A/Asie ont été isolées dans six centres au moins, des souches B dans cinq au moins. D'après les résultats des examens sérologiques, il semble que les virus B soient responsables de la plupart des poussées observées, surtout chez les jeunes. (Rapport du 13 février 1959.)

INFLUENZA

America

Canada. Several outbreaks of acute respiratory infections have been notified in Alberta, British Columbia, of the North-West Territories and Newfoundland and Prince Edward Island, during January.

Asia

Localized influenza epidemics have been notified in different parts of India. Investigations in all cases except one have shown A₂ strains to be responsible.

Europe

The incidence of influenza-like illnesses rose sharply during the second week of January in Switzerland. These outbreaks are most marked in the cantons of Zurich, Schwyz, Basel (town and country), Graubunden, Ticino, Neuchâtel and Genève. In France, epidemics of a similar nature, localized at first (during the second half of January) have spread throughout the whole country. Outbreaks are mild and the cause of infection is still being studied; a B-type virus is present in Paris, also in the West, Centre and East of the country. In Denmark the last two weeks have shown a marked rise in the incidence of an influenza-like disease among school-children. The clinical disease is mild and there is no spread of the disease among adults. Serological examinations at present show characteristics of type B influenza. In the Netherlands* influenza B has spread considerably; it affects mostly children. Pneumonia is very rare but a few deaths due to staphylococcal pneumonia have been notified.

*United Kingdom.** In England and Wales the number of notifications of pneumonia and deaths attributable to influenza has risen sharply during the last week and the illness is widespread throughout the country. Virus A, similar to the Asian group has been isolated in at least six centres and virus B in at least five centres. The results of serological tests tend to suggest that most of the outbreaks, particularly those in younger persons, are due to influenza B. (Report dated 13 February 1959.)
