NOTES SUR LES UNITÉS GÉOGRAPHIQUES

NOTE ON GEOGRAPHIC AREAS

Il ne faudrait pas conclure de la présentation adoptée dans le *Relevé épidémiologique hebdomadaire* que l'Organisation Mondiale de la Santé admet ou reconnaît officiellement le statut ou les limites des territoires mentionnés. Ce mode de présentation n'a d'autre objet que de donner un cadre géographique aux renseignements publiés. La même réserve vaut également pour toutes les notes et explications relatives aux pays et territoires qui figurent dans les tableaux. Les « circonscriptions » (voir définition de ce terme dans le Règlement sanitaire international) sont présentées suivant les notifications reçues des administrations sanitaires.

The form of presentation in the *Weekly Epidemiological Record* does not imply official endorsement or acceptance by the World Health Organization of the status or boundaries of the territories as listed or described. It has been adopted solely for the purpose of providing a convenient geographic basis for the information herein. The same qualification applies to all notes and explanations concerning the geographic units for which data are provided. Local areas under the International Sanitary Regulations are presented as designated by health administrations.

INFORMATIONS ÉPIDÉMIOLOGIQUES — EPIDEMIOLOGICAL NOTES

GRIPPE

Amérique

*Etats-Unis.*¹ — Des poussées épidémiques d'allure grippale ont maintenant été rapportées par 21 Etats et par le District de Columbia. En plus des Etats énumérés la semaine dernière, on relève pour la première fois cette semaine le Kentucky, la Virginie de l'Ouest, l'Indiana, le Tennessee, le Minnesota, l'Oklahoma, le Michigan et le New Jersey. L'infection à virus A2 a été mise en évidence, par isolement du virus ou par examens d'échantillons successifs de sérum, dans le District de Columbia et dans les Etats de Maryland, Kansas, Caroline du Nord, Virginie, New York, Illinois, Michigan, Massachusetts, Minnesota et Ohio. Les poussées d'allure grippale, dont l'extension s'était limitée à la côte atlantique pendant le mois de janvier, semblent maintenant se propager plus à l'ouest.

Les informations suivantes concernent les Etats nouvellement touchés: presque toutes les parties du *Kentucky* sont atteintes, et l'affection y est relativement bénigne; l'est de la *Virginie de l'Ouest* a rapporté une incidence anormalement élevée pour la saison; l'*Indiana* a rapporté une épidémie dans une école secondaire proche du *Kentucky*; 2 souches de virus A2 ont été isolées à Fort Snelling, *Minnesota*, au cours d'une épidémie circonscrite, dans un hôpital de vétérans; 2 épidémies ont atteint une école et une maison de correction dans la région d'Oklahoma City, *Oklahoma*; en *Michigan*, 6 souches de virus A2 ont été isolées au cours d'une épidémie parmi les employés d'un grand magasin de Lansing, et l'incidence des consultations hospitalières d'urgence augmenta à *Détroit*; enfin, 8 comtés sont affectés dans diverses parties de *New Jersey*.

Les informations suivantes concernent des développements survenus dans des Etats mentionnés dans les numéros précédents du *Relevé*: à *Atlanta*, en *Géorgie*, plusieurs sources ont rapporté une incidence accrue des affections respiratoires d'allure grippale; en *Illinois*, la poussée de la Station d'Entraînement Naval des Grands Lacs est maintenant sur son déclin, cependant que le virus A2 a été isolé dans 4 cas sporadiques dans les régions d'Urbana et de *Chicago*, et qu'une épidémie circonscrite a été observée dans une maison de correction de cette dernière ville; 3 nouvelles souches de virus A2 ont été isolées dans l'est du *Kansas*, et des poussées bénignes sont rapportées dans diverses communautés de cette région; 2 souches de virus A2 ont été isolées au cours d'une épidémie dans une université de *Boston*, *Massachusetts*; dans l'Etat de *New York*, les quelques indices d'activité épidémique restent faibles par rapport aux chiffres élevés de décès par pneumonie et grippe, malgré 7 observations sérologiques d'infection due au virus A2; 4 souches de virus A2 ont été isolées dans la moitié sud de l'*Ohio*, où plusieurs communautés sont atteintes; enfin 2 localités ont été affectées en *Vermont*.

Europe

République fédérale d'Allemagne. — Le Centre de la Grippe de *Hambourg* rapporte que, lors d'une épidémie d'affections fébriles, avec rhinite et trachéite, observée dans toute la partie nord de l'*Allemagne*, quelques souches de virus A2 ont été isolées, mais ce virus n'est pas considéré comme étant l'agent étiologique de l'épidémie.

Le Centre de la Grippe de *Marbourg-sur-Lahn* rapporte qu'une épidémie d'affections respiratoires fébriles d'allure grippale sévit depuis début février dans le nord de la *Hesse*. Le taux des malades enregistré par les caisses d'assurances maladies de *Marbourg-sur-Lahn* est passé de 6,5% au 15 janvier à 15,4% au 15 février.

D'après les examens des sérums couplés prélevés chez 20 malades, il semble que l'on ait mis en évidence une infection causée par un virus grippal du type A, probablement du sous-type A2.

Suisse. — Depuis début février, l'incidence des affections d'allure grippale augmente. Les chiffres actuels sont élevés dans presque tous les cantons, particulièrement ceux de l'est du pays. Des souches de virus A2 ont été isolées à l'Institut d'Hygiène publique de *Bâle*.

INFLUENZA

America

*United States.*¹ — Outbreaks of influenza-like disease have now been reported from 21 States and from the District of Columbia. The States reporting outbreaks this week for the first time include *Kentucky*, *West Virginia*, *Indiana*, *Tennessee*, *Minnesota*, *Oklahoma*, *Michigan* and *New Jersey*. Evidence of infection with Virus A2 has been obtained by virus isolation or by the examination of serial specimens of serum in the District of Columbia, in *Maryland*, *Kansas*, *North Carolina*, *Virginia*, *New York*, *Illinois*, *Michigan*, *Massachusetts*, *Minnesota* and *Ohio*. The disease, during January, tended to confine itself to the Atlantic coast, but is now spreading west.

The following information refers to the States experiencing new outbreaks: epidemics of a relatively mild form affect nearly all parts of *Kentucky*; in the east of *West Virginia* an above-seasonal incidence has been noted; *Indiana* has reported an outbreak in a high school, near *Kentucky*; 2 strains of Virus A2 were isolated at Fort Snelling, *Minnesota*, during a limited outbreak at the Veterans Administration Hospital; 2 epidemics have been observed at one high school and one reformatory, in the area of *Oklahoma City*, *Oklahoma*; in *Michigan*, 6 strains of Virus A2 have been isolated in an outbreak which was restricted to employees of a store, at *Lansing*, and an increase of influenza-like cases seen in hospital emergency rooms, in *Detroit*, has been noted; finally, in *New Jersey*, 8 counties have been affected—they are located in different sections of the State.

The following information refers to the situation in States for which outbreaks were reported in previous issues of the *Record*: in *Atlanta*, *Georgia*, an increase in cases of influenza-like respiratory illness has been reported from several sources; in *Illinois*, the outbreak among recruits at the Great Lakes Naval Training Station is declining, while isolations of Virus A2 have been obtained from 4 sporadic cases from the *Chicago* and *Urbana* areas, and a limited outbreak has been reported from the *Chicago House of Correction*; in the east of *Kansas*, where mild community outbreaks have been noted, 3 further strains of Virus A2 have been isolated; 2 strains of Virus A2 have also been isolated during an outbreak in a University of *Boston*, *Massachusetts*; in the State of *New York*, the high mortality due to pneumonia and influenza has been out of proportion to other indices of epidemic activity—serological evidence of Virus A2 infection has however been obtained from 7 cases; several communities have been affected in the southern half of *Ohio* and 4 strains of Virus A2 have been isolated; finally, in *Vermont*, outbreaks have been reported from 2 localities.

Europe

Federal Republic of Germany. — The Influenza Centre of *Hambourg* reported that in the course of a widespread epidemic characterized by pyrexia, rhinitis and tracheitis, in *North Germany*, a few strains of Virus A2 were isolated from cases but the epidemic is not considered to be due to this virus.

The Influenza Centre of *Marburg-an-der-Lahn* reports an influenza-like outbreak of febrile respiratory illness which began in the north of *Hess* at the beginning of February. The records of the sickness insurance companies of *Marburg-an-der-Lahn* show that the claim rate has risen from 6.5 per cent on 15 January to 15.4 per cent on 15 February.

Examination of paired sera from 20 patients seems to indicate infection with Influenza Virus of Type A, probably Sub-Type A2.

Switzerland. — The incidence of influenza-like illness has increased since the beginning of February and is now high in almost all cantons, especially in the east of the country. Strains of Virus A2 have been isolated at the Institute of Public Health, *Basel*.
