Etats-Unis.¹ — Des poussées d'allure grippale ont maintenant été rapportées par le District de Columbia et par 34 états, parmi lesquels on relève pour la première fois cette semaine le Wisconsin, le Rhode Island, le Montana et l'Arizona. L'infection à virus A2 a maintenant été mise en évidence par isolement du virus ou par examens d'échantillons successifs de sérums dans le District de Columbia et dans 19 états, parmi lesquels on relève pour la première fois cette semaine, le Wisconsin, le Rhode Island et le Montana.

En *Arizona* une poussée épidémique due à une affection d'allure grippale a atteint toute une communauté de l'est, qui a dû fermer les écoles primaires et secondaires; une autre poussée a été observée dans deux réserves indiennes du nord de l'état où tous les groupes d'âge semblent avoir été affectés. Dans le *Montana*, une affection analogue a causé une épidémie dans toute la population d'une ville du nord-ouest, et l'infection à virus A2 a été mise en évidence à l'Université de Montana (à Missoula), par les examens sérologiques d'un cas isolé. Dans le *Rhode Island*, des poussées ont été notées dans les Comtés de Providence et de Newport, avec absentéisme scolaire élevé, et l'infection à virus A2 a été mise en évidence par les examens sérologiques d'un malade à Woonsocket City. Dans le *Wisconsin*, à Milwaukee, une épidémie qui avait commencé dans un hôpital de vétérans s'est ensuite étendue à toute la ville, et l'infection à virus A2 a été mise en évidence par les examens de sérums couplés chez 5 malades.

Parmi les états mentionnés dans les numéros précédents du *Relevé*, on note de nouvelles poussées et l'isolement de nouvelles souches de virus A2 en *Georgie* et dans l'état de *New York*.

United States.¹ — Outbreaks of influenza-like disease have now been reported from the District of Columbia and from 34 States. The States reporting outbreaks for the first time this week include Wisconsin, Rhode Island, Montana and Arizona. Evidence of infection with Virus A2 has been obtained by virus isolation or by the examination of serial specimens of serum in the District of Columbia and in 19 States including for the first time this week Wisconsin, Rhode Island and Montana.

In *Arizona*, a community-wide outbreak of influenza-like illness occurred in the east of the State, and elementary and high schools had to be closed; in addition, an outbreak has been reported from 2 Indian Reservations in the northern part of the State; all age groups have apparently been affected. In *Montana*, an epidemic of a similar illness affected the whole population of a northwestern town, and evidence of infection with Virus A2 was obtained at the University of Montana (Missoula) by the examination of sera from one isolated case. In *Rhode Island*, outbreaks with high absenteeism in schools were observed in Providence and Newport Counties; evidence of infection with Virus A2 was obtained by the examination of sera from one patient at Woonsocket City. In *Wisconsin*, an outbreak which began at the Veterans Administration Hospital, Milwaukee, has spread throughout the town; evidence of infection with Virus A2 was obtained by the examination of paired sera from 5 patients.

Among the States mentioned in previous issues of the *Record*, new outbreaks and the isolation of further strains of Virus A2 have been reported from *Georgia* and from the State of *New York*.

Europe

Danemark. — Aucun indice de grippe épidémique n'a été observé jusqu'ici. Les examens sérologiques ont permis de mettre en évidence 2 cas isolés d'infection à virus C survenus en janvier, ainsi qu'un cas d'infection à virus A survenu vers mi-février, au nord de Copenhague, chez un soldat atteint d'une affection bénigne.

Norvège. — Des affections d'allure grippale attribuées au virus A2 ont été observées dans le Rogaland depuis début février.

Royaume-Uni: Centre OMS de la Grippe, Glasgow. — Une souche de virus A2, apparentée à la souche A2/57, a été isolée chez un malade examiné début février.

Suède. — Depuis mi-février, de petites poussées d'une affection respiratoire bénigne d'allure grippale ont été observées principalement dans le centre, en particulier dans les villes de Gothenburg, Eskilstuna et Örebro, ainsi que dans quelques unités militaires. L'infection à virus A a été mise en évidence par les examens sérologiques, au cours de certaines de ces poussées.

En janvier, l'infection à virus B avait été mise en évidence par les examens sérologiques dans 2 cas sporadiques survenus à Örebro et Östersund.

*Suisse.*¹ — Le nombre de cas d'allure grippale a encore augmenté pendant la semaine du 24 février au 2 mars. L'infection à virus A a été mise en évidence dans un certain nombre de cas par l'Institut d'Hygiène de Berne, après examen d'échantillons successifs de sérum.

Europe

Danemark. — There is as yet no indication of epidemic influenza. Evidence of infection with Virus C was obtained in January by the examination of sera from 2 sporadic cases; in the middle of February, evidence of infection with Virus A was obtained by the examination of sera from a soldier suffering from a mild form of influenza in the north of Copenhagen.

Norway. — Since the beginning of February cases of influenza-like illness attributed to Virus A2 have been observed in Rogaland.

United Kingdom: WHO Influenza Centre, Glasgow. — A strain of Virus A2 related to A2/57 was isolated from a clinical case examined early in February.

Sweden. — Small outbreaks of a mild influenza-like respiratory illness have been noted since the middle of February. They affect particularly the centre of the country and especially the towns of Gothenburg, Eskilstuna and Örebro as well as a few military units. In certain of these outbreaks, evidence of infection with Virus A was obtained by serological examination.

In January, evidence of infection with Virus B had been obtained by the examination of sera from 2 sporadic cases at Örebro and Östersund.

*Switzerland.*¹ — The number of cases of influenza-like illness continued to increase during the week 24 February-2 March. Evidence of infection with Virus A was obtained at the Hygiene Institute, Bern, by the examination of serial specimens of serum from several cases.

*Birmanie: Rangoon (P, A).*¹ — Un cas de variole a été rapporté chez un enfant d'un an qui était arrivé par avion de Calcutta le 31 janvier. L'affection s'est déclarée le 13 février. Le malade avait été vacciné deux fois sans succès.

Il est rappelé qu'aux termes du Règlement sanitaire international, Rangoon ne saurait, en raison de ce cas importé, être considéré comme une circonscription infectée de variole.

*Burma: Rangoon (P, A).*¹ — A case of smallpox has been reported in a one year old child, who arrived from Calcutta by air on 31 January. The disease started on 13 February. The patient had been vaccinated twice without success.

It is recalled that, under the provisions of the Regulations, Rangoon may not, on account of this imported case, be considered as a smallpox infected local area.
