INFORMATIONS ÉPIDÉMIOLOGIQUES — EPIDEMIOLOGICAL NOTES

GRIPPE

Aucune épidémie confirmée n'a encore été signalée dans le monde pour l'automne 1962.

Rappelons brièvement l'aspect des épidémies relatées dans le *Relevé épidémiologique hebdomadaire* entre novembre 1961 et juin 1962. En Amérique, c'est le virus B qui fut essentiellement en cause dans les vastes épidémies qui affectèrent le Canada et les États-Unis (où 43 états identifièrent ce virus). En Asie, c'est le virus A2 qui fut essentiellement en cause dans les épidémies qui survinrent en République de Corée (1 300 000 cas cliniques), au Japon (où Tokyo et 32 préfectures sur 46 furent atteintes), en Fédération de Malaisie, à Singapour et dans la partie asiatique de l'URSS (Asie centrale, Sibérie, Extrême-Orient). En Europe, les virus A2 et B furent tous deux en cause; le virus A2 fut le principal responsable des épidémies de Finlande, de Hongrie (2 millions et demi de cas cliniques), de Norvège, de Suède, de Tchécoslovaquie et d'URSS (Moscou et centre du pays); le virus B fut le principal responsable des épidémies de la République fédérale d'Allemagne, d'Irlande (rares poussées localisées), de Pologne (plus de 2 millions de cas en janvier 1962), du Royaume-Uni (rares poussées localisées) et de Suisse; enfin, les virus A2 et B furent en cause l'un et l'autre dans le même pays pour les épidémies survenues au Danemark, en France, aux Pays-Bas et en Yougoslavie.

Après ce bref rappel des informations publiées jusqu'en juin 1962, voici une énumération des informations reçues après cette période (la plupart sont des informations tardives concernant la saison novembre 1961-juin 1962): 1) poussée localisée, avec isolement d'un virus A2, survenue fin mars 1962 au Canada, à la station de la RCAF de Penhold, Alberta; 2) poussée localisée, avec isolement d'un virus A2, survenue en mai 1962 aux États-Unis, dans un hôpital de vétérans du Minnesota; 3) isolement d'un virus A2 en avril 1962 chez un malade isolé de Chicago, Illinois; 4) épidémie survenue fin mai-début juin 1962 dans les îles Samoa américaines, et attribuée au virus A2 en raison des données sérologiques mises en évidence; 5) isolement de virus A2 au printemps 1962 dans des cas sporadiques survenus à São Paulo, Brésil (où le virus B avait été isolé en mars et avril 1962¹); 6) épidémie survenue en mai et juin 1962 dans la zone du canal de Panama, avec isolement de virus B « présumé »; 7) épidémie attribuée au virus A2 qui fut observée aux Philippines en août 1962.²

INFLUENZA

No confirmed outbreak has been reported so far for the Autumn 1962.

The characteristics of the epidemics reported in the *Weekly Epidemiological Record* between November 1961 and June 1962 are summarized hereafter. In America, the important outbreaks in Canada and in the United States were due to Virus B (this virus was identified in 43 States of the USA). In Asia, Virus A2 was mainly responsible for the outbreaks observed in the Republic of Korea (1 300 000 clinical cases), in Japan (where Tokyo and 32 Prefectures—out of 46—were affected), in the Federation of Malaya, in Singapore and in the Asiatic part of USSR (Central Asia, Siberia, Far East). In Europe, both Virus A2 and Virus B were responsible; outbreaks in Finland, Hungary (two and a half million clinical cases), Norway, Sweden, Czechoslovakia and USSR (Moscow and the central part of the country) were mainly due to Virus A2; in the Federal Republic of Germany, Ireland (a few localized outbreaks), Poland (over two million cases in January 1962), United Kingdom (a few localized outbreaks) and Switzerland, Virus B was mainly responsible; finally, in Denmark, France, Netherlands and Yugoslavia, the epidemics reported in each of these countries were due to both Virus A2 and Virus B.

After this short summary of information published up to June 1962, an account of the reports received after that date is given below (in most cases the information relates to the period November 1961 to June 1962): (1) localized outbreak, with isolation of virus A2, in Penhold RCAF Station, Alberta, Canada—end of March 1962; (2) localized outbreak, with isolation of Virus A2 in a Veterans Hospital of Minnesota, United States of America—May 1962; (3) isolation of Virus A2 from an isolated case, in Chicago, Illinois—April 1962; (4) outbreak attributed to Virus A2, on the basis of seriological findings, in American Samoa—end of May/beginning of June 1962; (5) isolation—in Spring 1962—of Virus A2 from sporadic cases in São Paulo, Brazil (where Virus B had been isolated in March and April 1962¹); (6) epidemic, with isolation of "presumptive" Virus B, in the Panama Canal Zone—May and June 1962; (7) epidemic attributed to Virus A2 in the Philippines—August 1962.²
