Local areas under the International Sanitary Regulations are presented as designated by health administrations.

Fiji Islands (with dependency). — On 7 May 1963, the United Kingdom Government notified the Organization of the withdrawal of the reservation to Article 100 of the International Sanitary Regulations, 1951, made on behalf of the Fiji Islands (with dependency).

INFORMATIONS ÉPIDÉMIOLOGIQUES — EPIDEMIOLOGICAL NOTES

CHOLÉRA

Asie

Japan. — Le 13 mai 1963, l'administration sanitaire du Japon a fait savoir par télégramme qu'un cas importé de choléra avait été confirmé à Kawaguchiko (Préfecture de Yamanashi). Il s'agit d'un jardinier anglais âgé de 22 ans, en provenance de Bombay, qui était arrivé à Tokyo le 7 mai par le vol Air-India N° 112, via New Delhi, Bangkok, Hong Kong; il semblait alors être en bonne santé et possédait un certificat international de vaccination valable contre le choléra, daté des 5 et 12 mars 1963. Les symptômes commencèrent le 9 mai; le malade fut isolé à l'hôpital le 10 mai et le laboratoire confirma le diagnostic de choléra (type Inaba) le 12 mai. Peu avant de quitter Bombay, il s'était rendu dans plusieurs régions de l'Inde, dont Calcutta.

Les mesures de contrôle nécessaires ont été prises. En particulier, on a procédé à la recherche des contacts et à la désinfection dans les endroits où le voyageur s'était rendu.

Les états de la Région du Pacifique occidental, ainsi que ceux où l'avion fit escale, ont été avisés télégraphiquement par l'OMS le 13 mai. Cette information est en outre diffusée depuis le 14 mai dans le bulletin radio-télégraphique quotidien de l'OMS (section 3).

Il est rappelé qu'aux termes du Règlement sanitaire international, Kawaguchiko (Préfecture de Yamanashi) ne saurait, en raison de ce cas importé de choléra, être considérée comme une circonscription infectée de choléra.

Malaisie. — 44 cas et 2 décès ont été rapportés le 10 mai dans le port de Malacca. Le premier cas avait été observé le 3 mai. Le laboratoire a confirmé qu'il s'agissait de vibron cholérique (type Ogawa). C'est la première fois depuis 1937 qu'une circonscription de Malaisie est infectée de choléra. La source de l'infection n'est pas encore connue.

CHOLERA

Asia

Japan. — By telegram sent on 13 May, the health administration of Japan has notified one imported cholera case in Kawaguchiko, Yamanashi Prefecture. The patient, an English gardener aged 22, arrived in Tokyo on 7 May from Bombay by Air India flight 112, via New Delhi, Bangkok, Hong Kong. He appeared to be in good health, and he was in possession of a valid international vaccination certificate against cholera, dated 5 and 12 March 1963. Symptoms began on 9 May; he was isolated in hospital on 10 May, and the laboratory confirmed the diagnosis of cholera (Inaba type) on 12 May. Shortly before departure from Bombay, he had visited several areas in India, including Calcutta.

Necessary control measures have been taken in places visited by the patient, such as contact tracing and disinfection.

States in the Western Pacific Region, as well as States where Air India flight 112 stopped, have been advised telegraphically by WHO on 13 May. In addition, this information has appeared in the WHO daily epidemiological radio-telegraphic bulletin since May 14 (Section 3).

It is recalled that, under the provisions of the International Sanitary Regulations, Kawaguchiko, Yamanashi Prefecture, may not be considered as a cholera infected local area on the basis of this one imported cholera case.

Malaya. — 44 cases and 2 deaths have been notified in the port of Malacca on 10 May. The first case had been observed on 3 May. Laboratory examinations revealed that these were caused by cholera vibrio of the Ogawa type. Since 1937, this is the first time that a local area in Malaya is infected with cholera. The source of infection is not yet known.

GRIPPE

Amérique

Canada. — Pendant les deux premières semaines de mars, des poussées d'allure grippale, affectant tous les groupes d'âge, ont été rapportées dans plusieurs localités des provinces de *New Brunswick* et *Nova Scotia*, sans que l'infection à virus grippal ait été mise en évidence.

Du 15 février au 19 mars, des vagues épidémiques d'allure grippale ont été rapportées dans le *Saskatchewan*. Une première vague, survenue dans plusieurs zones des régions centrale et méridionale, a été attribuée au virus para-grippal (types I et II), mais au cours d'une vague suivante, observée dans le sud-est de la province, des souches de virus A2 ont été isolées; ces souches semblent analogues à la souche A2/Asian/57; cette dernière poussée a atteint tous les groupes d'âge.

Début mars, une incidence accrue d'affection à allure grippale a été rapportée dans le *Manitoba*. Enfin, une poussée d'allure grippale a été observée dans une école de la province de *Québec*, fin février-début mars.

INFLUENZA

America

Canada. — In the first two weeks of March, outbreaks of influenza-like illness, affecting all age groups, were reported from several localities in the Provinces of *New Brunswick* and *Nova Scotia*. No evidence of infection with influenza virus was obtained.

Between 15 February and 19 March, epidemic waves of influenza-like illness were reported in *Saskatchewan*. The first wave, which occurred in various areas of the south and middle of the Province, was attributed to para-influenza viruses types I and II, but in a later wave, in the south-east corner of the Province, strains of influenza Virus type A2 were isolated; these strains seem to be similar to A2/Asian/57; this outbreak affected all age groups.

Early in March, an increased incidence of influenza-like illness was reported from *Manitoba*. An outbreak of influenza-like illness was also observed in a school, in the Province of *Quebec*, between the end of February and the beginning of March.

Etats-Unis. — La mortalité par pneumonie et grippe est redevenue pratiquement conforme aux prévisions dans toutes les régions des États-Unis. Des poussées d'allure grippale ont maintenant été rapportées par le *District of Columbia* et par 43 états, parmi lesquels on relève pour la première fois l'*Etat de Washington* (rapport en retard d'une poussée dans un jardin d'enfants qui culmina le 12 mars). L'infection à virus A2 a maintenant été mise en évidence par isolement du virus ou par examens sérologiques dans le *District of Columbia* et dans 38 états, parmi lesquels on relève pour la première fois le *Nouveau Mexique* (évidence sérologique dans 5 comtés en avril, sans poussées épidémiques) et l'*Etat de Washington* (isolement du virus A2 au cours de la poussée mentionnée ci-dessus, et évidence sérologique dans plusieurs régions sans augmentation de l'incidence des affections d'allure grippale).

Parmi les états de l'*Est* et du *Centre Ouest*, seul, le *Minnesota* a rapporté deux poussées récentes dans le nord de l'état. Dans les régions des *Montagnes* et du *Pacifique* seul, l'*Alaska* a rapporté de vastes poussées dans des groupes de population (nombreuses poussées depuis la semaine terminée le 29 mars); la *Californie* a continué à rapporter la mise en évidence de l'infection à virus A2 dans de nombreuses régions, avec absence de poussées parmi les populations pour beaucoup d'entre elles (la plupart des poussées se limitant à des institutions), et l'*Utah* a rapporté une nouvelle poussée dans le nord-ouest.

America (continued)

United States. — Pneumonia-influenza mortality has returned essentially to expected levels in all regions of the country. Outbreaks of influenza-like disease have now been reported from the *District of Columbia* and from 43 States, including for the first time the *State of Washington* (late report of an outbreak in a kindergarten which reached its peak on 12 March). Evidence of infection with virus A2 has now been obtained by virus isolation or by serological tests in the *District of Columbia* and in 38 States, including for the first time the States of *New Mexico* (serological evidence during April in 5 counties without epidemic outbreaks) and *Washington* (isolation of A2 virus during the above-mentioned outbreak, and serological evidence obtained in various regions without an increase in the incidence of influenza-like illness).

Of the *East* and *Middle West* States, only *Minnesota* reported two recent outbreaks in the northern region of the State. In the *Mountain* and *Pacific* regions, only *Alaska* reported wide scale community outbreaks (numerous outbreaks since week ending 29 March); *California* has continued to report laboratory evidence of infection with virus A2 in many areas: in many of them there was no evidence of community outbreaks and most outbreaks occurred in institutions. *Utah* reported a new outbreak in the North-West area.

PÈLERINAGE DE LA MECQUE

L'administration sanitaire de l'Arabie saoudite a informé l'Organisation en date du 7 mai que le pèlerinage de La Mecque pour l'année 1963 (année 1382 de l'Hégire) était resté indemne de maladies quaranténaires.

MECCA PILGRIMAGE

The health administration of Saudi Arabia informed the Organization on 7 May that the Mecca Pilgrimage for 1963 (year of the Hegira 1382) remained free of quarantinable diseases.
