Sarawak: District d'Upper Kuching (Kuching supérieur). — L'administration sanitaire de Sarawak a déclaré circonscription infectée de choléra, à partir du 1^{er} janvier 1963, le district d'Upper Kuching situé dans la Division de Kuching (1^{re} Division). Cette décision a été prise à la suite de trois cas confirmés de choléra El Tor qui se sont produits dans un seul village proche de la frontière de la province indonésienne de Kalimantan. Il n'y a pas eu de décès.

Cette poussée épidémique paraît n'avoir aucun rapport avec celle qui vient de s'éteindre plus à l'est dans le district d'Upper Serian (Serian supérieur) situé également dans la Division de Kuching, près de la frontière de Kalimantan. Le district de Lower Kuching (Kuching inférieur), qui comprend le port de Kuching, est indemne.

Les mesures nécessaires ont été prises: enquête et vaccination dans toute la zone atteinte, barrière de vaccinations autour de cette zone, traitement et isolement des personnes qui présentent diarrhée et vomissements, campagne d'éducation sanitaire.

Sarawak: Upper Kuching District. — Upper Kuching District, in Kuching (First) Division, was notified as a cholera infected local area, by the health administration of Sarawak, as from 1 January 1963. This decision was taken after the reporting of three confirmed cases of cholera El Tor in a village situated near the border with the Indonesian Province of Kalimantan. No deaths were reported.

This outbreak seems to have no relation with the outbreak—now terminated—which was observed eastward, in Upper Serian District, also in Kuching Division, near the frontier with Kalimantan. Lower Kuching District, including Kuching (P), is free of infection.

Appropriate measures have been taken as follows: survey and vaccination in the whole area affected, and barrier vaccination around this area; treatment and isolation of persons suffering from diarrhoea with vomiting; health education campaign.
