NOTES SUR LES UNITÉS GÉOGRAPHIQUES — NOTES ON GEOGRAPHIC AREAS

Il ne faudrait pas conclure de la présentation adoptée dans le *Relevé épidémiologique hebdomadaire* que l'Organisation mondiale de la Santé admet ou reconnaît officiellement le statut ou les limites des territoires mentionnés. Ce mode de présentation n'a d'autre objet que de donner un cadre géographique aux renseignements publiés. La même réserve vaut également pour toutes les notes et explications relatives aux pays et territoires qui figurent dans les tableaux. Les « circoncriptions » (voir définition de ce terme dans le Règlement sanitaire international) sont présentées suivant les notifications reçues des administrations sanitaires.

The form of presentation in the *Weekly Epidemiological Record* does not imply official endorsement or acceptance by the World Health Organization of the status or boundaries of the territories as listed or described. It has been adopted solely for the purpose of providing a convenient geographic basis for the information herein. The same qualification applies to all notes and explanations concerning the geographic units for which data are provided. Local areas under the International Sanitary Regulations are presented as designated by health administrations.

INFORMATIONS ÉPIDÉMIOLOGIQUES — EPIDEMIOLOGICAL NOTES

CHOLÉRA

Asie

Hong Kong. — Conformément aux dispositions de l'article 3, l'administration sanitaire de Hong Kong a déclaré son territoire circonscription infectée de choléra le 19 février, date à laquelle un cas a été notifié.

Les administrations sanitaires de la région du Pacifique ont été avisées par télégramme (en CODEPID) le 19 février. Cette information est également diffusée dans le *bulletin épidémiologique radio-télégraphique quotidien* depuis le 20 février.

Inde. — Le 12 février, le bateau INDIAN SPLENDOR a débarqué à Calcutta un membre de son équipage suspect de choléra. Le bateau avait fait escale à Bombay le 28 janvier, mais ce port est indemne de choléra et le médecin du port de Calcutta, dans un télégramme envoyé directement à l'Organisation, a rapporté que l'infection provenait probablement de Calcutta. Les mesures nécessaires ont été prises. Le bateau est reparti directement pour Bombay, et ce port a été informé par télégramme de Calcutta.

La notification ci-dessus a été faite conformément au nouveau paragraphe 2 (sous-paragraphe b) de l'article 3 du Règlement sanitaire international.

CHOLERA

Asia

Hong Kong. — The health administration of Hong Kong, under the provisions of Article 3, declared its territory a cholera infected local area on 19 February. One case was notified on that date.

Health administrations in the Pacific area were notified by telegram (in CODEPID) on 19 February. Information was also given in the *daily epidemiological radio-telegraphic bulletin* beginning 20 February.

India. — A suspected case of cholera in a member of the crew of INDIAN SPLENDOR was disembarked at Calcutta on 12 February. The ship had left Bombay—a port free from cholera—on 28 January. The Port Health Officer, Calcutta, in a direct cable to the Organization, reports that the probable source of infection is Calcutta. All necessary measures have been taken. The ship returned directly to Bombay and this port was informed by cable from Calcutta.

The above notification was made in accordance with the new paragraph 2 (sub-paragraph b) of Article 3 of the Regulations.

PESTE

Afrique

Tanganyika. — 241 cas suspects de peste et 9 décès ont été rapportés le 12 février dans le District de Pare (Province de Tanga). Les mesures nécessaires ont été prises. Aucun cas de peste n'avait été rapporté depuis décembre 1962 par le Tanganyika (2 cas et 2 décès dans le District de Singida, Province centrale, pour la semaine terminée le 8 décembre 1962).

PLAGUE

Africa

Tanganyika. — 241 suspected cases of plague and 9 deaths were reported on 12 February in the District of Pare (Tanga Province). All necessary measures have been taken. No case of plague had been reported in Tanganyika since December 1962 (2 cases and 2 deaths in the District of Singida, Central Province, for the week ended 8 December 1962).

VARIOLE

Afrique

Dahomey. — Une épidémie de variole sévit dans la circonscription médicale de Zagnanado (Préfecture du Centre), où 176 cas et 10 décès ont été rapportés pour la semaine terminée le 11 février; auparavant, 96 cas avaient été rapportés dans cette circonscription pour la semaine terminée le 7 janvier et 30 cas pour la semaine terminée le 28 janvier. 285 cas et 32 décès avaient été enregistrés en 1963 pour l'ensemble du pays, mais la circonscription médicale de Zagnanado était restée indemne.

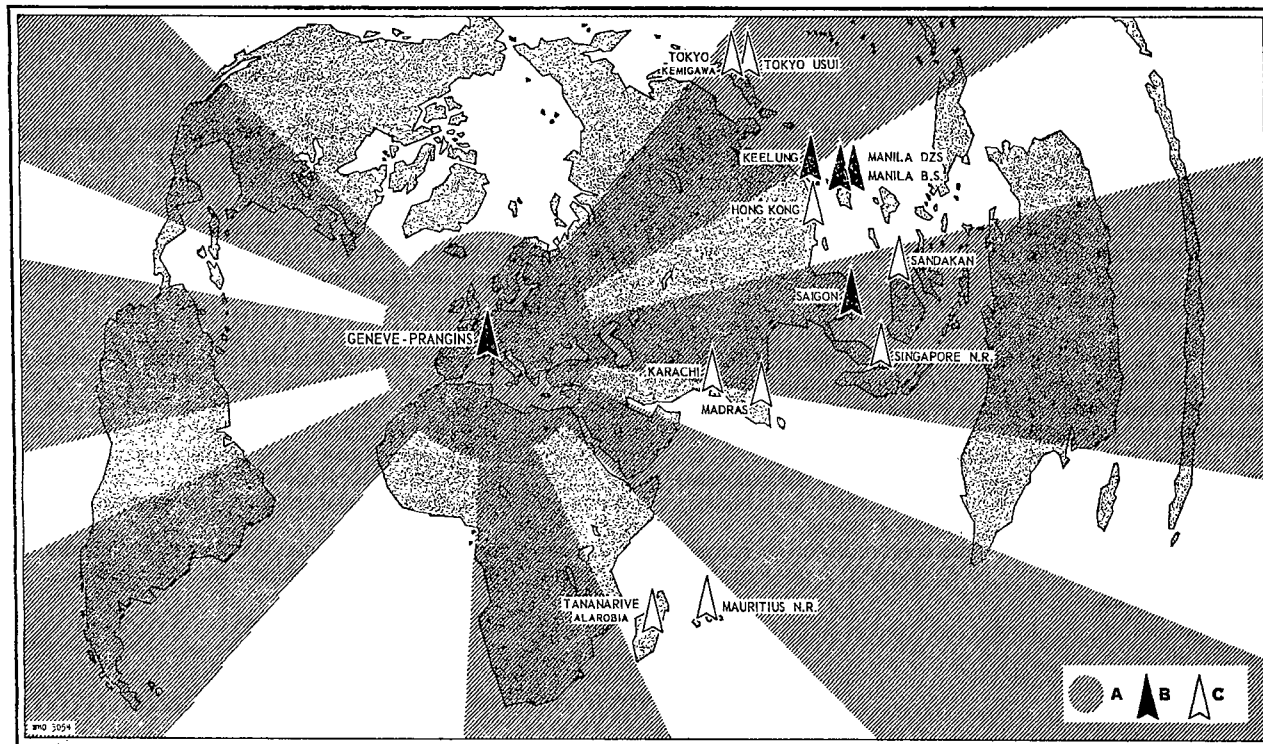
SMALLPOX

Africa

Dahomey. — An epidemic of smallpox is raging in the *circonscription médicale* of Zagnanado (*Préfecture du Centre*), where 176 cases and 10 deaths were reported for the week ended 11 February; 96 cases had been notified in this *circonscription* for the week ended 7 January, and 30 cases for the week ended 28 January. In 1963, a total of 285 cases and 32 deaths were reported for the whole country, but the *circonscription médicale* of Zagnanado remained free of infection.

L'Organisation mondiale de la Santé, à Genève, transmet par l'intermédiaire des postes émetteurs de Radio Suisse S.A. (Genève-Prangins), un *Bulletin épidémiologique radio-télégraphique quotidien* destiné aux administrations sanitaires. Ce bulletin contient les renseignements officiels reçus par l'OMS, à Genève, sur les cas de maladies quaranténaires, c'est-à-dire de peste, choléra, fièvre jaune, variole, typhus et fièvre récurrente, constatés dans les ports et les aéroports (section une); sur les déclarations de circonscriptions infectées; sur les déclarations de circonscriptions redevenues indemnes lorsqu'il s'agit a) d'un port ou d'un aéroport; b) de la dernière circonscription qui restait encore infectée par une maladie quarantenaire donnée, dans un pays (section deux); sur les cas de maladies quaranténaires constatés dans des localités autres que ports et aéroports (section trois); et enfin sur les épidémies de maladies non quaranténaires ayant un intérêt international suffisant (section quatre).

Les derniers renseignements reçus suivis des mots « fin des dernières informations » sont communiqués au début du message, afin de réduire les frais de réception des administrations sanitaires. Lorsqu'il n'y a pas de changement, le mot « répétition » précède le texte du bulletin.

Le bulletin est un complément au *Relevé épidémiologique hebdomadaire*.

Les conditions de réception du bulletin, ainsi que toutes observations et suggestions opportunes au sujet de sa teneur, seront signalées au Service de la Quarantaine internationale, OMS, Genève (adresse télégraphique: EPIDNATIONS GENÈVE).

Les postes émetteurs de Genève-Prangins qui transmettent le *Bulletin épidémiologique radio-télégraphique de l'OMS*, de même que les postes émetteurs retransmettant ce Bulletin, sont indiqués à la page 20.

The World Health Organization transmits over the Radio Suisse S.A. wireless station (Genève-Prangins) a *Daily Epidemiological Radio-telegraphic Bulletin* destined for health administrations. This bulletin contains official information received by WHO in Geneva on the occurrence of the quarantinable diseases, i.e. plague, cholera, yellow fever, smallpox, typhus and relapsing fever, in ports and airports (section one); on declarations of areas as infected or free from infection—declarations of areas free from infection are included only if (a) the area is a port or airport, or (b) the area is the last infected area for that particular disease in that country (section two); on cases of the quarantinable diseases in localities other than ports and airports (section three); and on outbreaks of non-quarantinable diseases if of sufficient international interest (section four).

The "latest information", followed by the words "end of latest information" is given at the beginning of the message, in order to reduce the cost of reception to health administrations. Whenever the text is not modified the word "repetition" is given at the beginning of the message.

The Bulletin complements the *Weekly Epidemiological Record*.

Reports on condition of reception, and any comments and suggestions regarding the contents of the bulletin, should be communicated to the International Quarantine Service, WHO, Geneva (cable address: EPIDNATIONS GENÈVE).

The Genève-Prangins stations transmitting the *Daily Epidemiological Radio-telegraphic Bulletin of WHO*, as well as those stations retransmitting this Radio Bulletin, are listed on page 20.
