INFORMATIONS ÉPIDÉMIOLOGIQUES — EPIDEMIOLOGICAL NOTES

GRIPPE

Amérique

Canada. — Une épidémie d'allure grippale avec complications pulmonaires a été rapportée en janvier à Lantzville, dans le centre de l'île de Vancouver, avec un sommet d'environ 1 000 cas pendant la semaine terminée le 17 janvier.

Des poussées d'une affection cliniquement analogue avaient causé 100 à 150 cas en décembre 1963 dans 3 villes des Territoires du Nord-Ouest. Ces poussées continuent; dans une région, les écoles ont été fermées.

Etats-Unis d'Amérique. — Une épidémie d'allure grippale a été observée fin janvier et début février dans le nord-ouest de l'Etat de Washington. Les examens de sérums couplés indiquent une infection à virus A2. Cette épidémie, qui a suivi de peu celle survenue à proximité, dans l'île de Vancouver, au Canada, atteint maintenant une grande partie du centre de l'Etat de Washington et un comté de l'est, à la frontière de l'Idaho. Les rapports mentionnent un absentéisme scolaire élevé.

D'autre part, une souche A2 a été isolée à l'Université de Michigan; le prélèvement avait été effectué chez un malade à fin janvier.

Asie

Japon. — (Information en date du 10 février.) Une épidémie d'allure grippale, qui avait commencé en janvier, a atteint environ 100 000 personnes dans l'île de Kyushu. L'affection est bénigne. La souche de virus B qui a été isolée (B/Amakusa/1/64) se rapproche de la souche (B/Osaka/8/61) de la dernière épidémie de grippe B survenue au Japon; elle ne ressemble pas à B/Taiwan/4/62, dont les différences antigéniques par rapport aux autres souches B ont été signalées précédemment.

Taiwan. — Une épidémie d'allure grippale a sévi à Taipei, atteignant son sommet vers mi-janvier; elle est maintenant sur son déclin. Le taux d'attaque fut estimé à 50% chez les enfants au moment du sommet de l'épidémie. Les tests sérologiques ont montré qu'une infection à virus A2 pouvait être suspectée.

Singapour. — Au cours d'une poussée d'allure grippale survenue en janvier 1964, plusieurs souches de virus B ont été isolées. Les tests préliminaires ont montré qu'elles diffèrent peut-être un peu de B/Johannesburg/33/58.

Europe

Royaume-Uni. — Une souche de virus A2 (semblable à A2/Nederland/65/63) a été isolée dans les Midlands, dans un cas qui avait débuté à fin janvier.

Une autre souche A a été isolée à Bristol chez un enfant de 3 ans atteint de croup à fin janvier.

INFLUENZA

America

Canada. — An epidemic of influenza-like illness with pulmonary complications was reported in January from Lantzville, in Central Vancouver Island. It reached its peak during the week ending 17 January, when it was estimated that 1 000 cases were reported.

In December 1963, outbreaks of a clinically similar illness were reported from 3 towns in the Northwest Territories, where 100 to 150 cases were observed. These outbreaks continue and in one area schools have been closed.

United States of America. — An outbreak of influenza-like illness occurred at the end of January and the beginning of February in northwestern Washington State. Tests on paired sera indicate infection with Virus A2. This epidemic, which followed closely a similar outbreak in nearby areas on Vancouver Island, Canada, has now spread widely in central Washington State and into one eastern county on the Idaho border. Reports mention high absence rates in school children.

A strain of Virus A2 was isolated at Michigan University, from a specimen taken from a patient ill in late January.

Asia

Japan. — (Information dated 10 February.) In an outbreak of mild influenza-like illness which began in January in Kyushu Island, it is estimated that 100 000 cases have occurred. The strain of Virus B isolated (B/Amakusa/1/64) is closely related to B/Osaka/8/61 isolated in the last epidemic of Influenza B, in Japan, but does not resemble B/Taiwan/4/62. (The antigenic differences between this Taiwan strain and other strains of Virus B have been reported previously.)

Taiwan. — An outbreak of influenza-like illness occurred in Taipei. It reached its peak in mid-January and is now declining. Attack rates have been estimated at 50% in children at the height of the epidemic. Serological tests suggest infection with Virus A2.

Singapore. — Several strains of Virus B were isolated during an outbreak of influenza-like illness which occurred in January. Preliminary tests show that these strains may somewhat differ from B/Johannesburg/33/58.

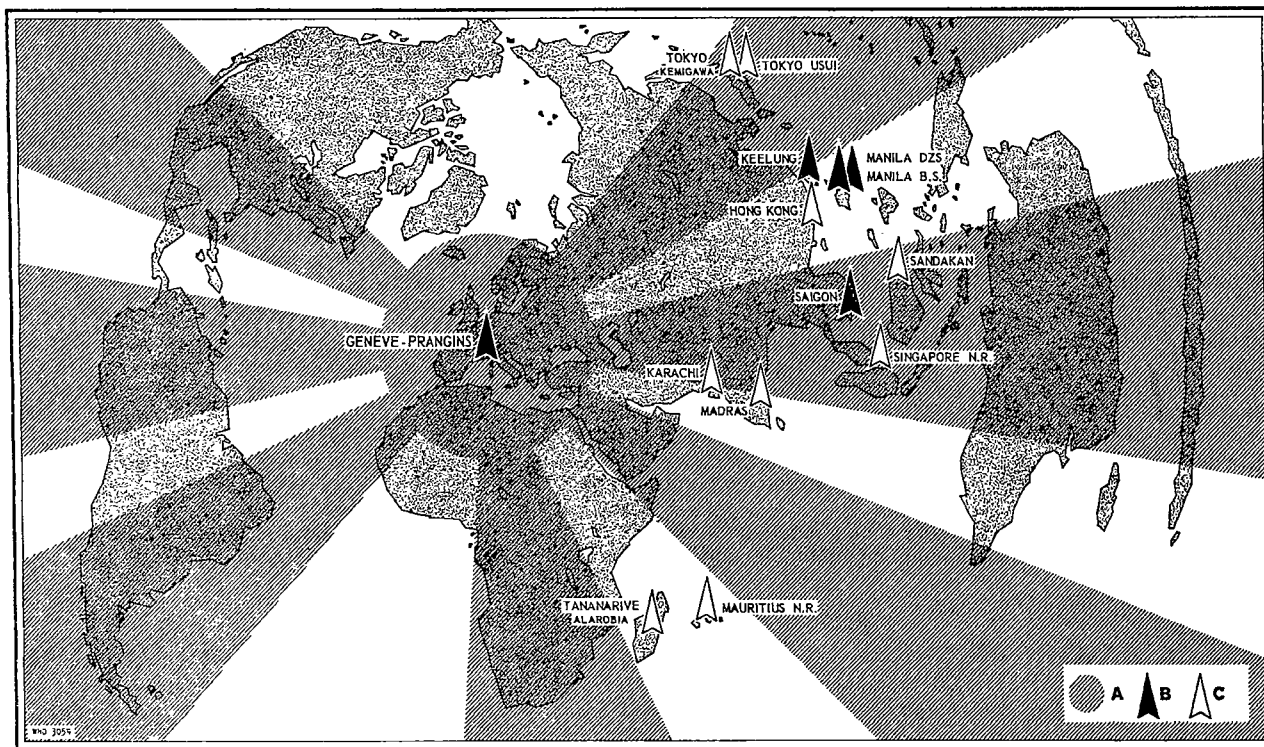
Europe

United Kingdom. — A strain of Virus A2 (similar to A2/Nederland/65/63) was isolated in the Midlands from a patient who developed symptoms late in January.

Another strain of Virus A was isolated in Bristol from a child aged 3 who had croup late in January.

SMALLPOX

Amérique

America

Pérou. — Deux cas de variole, provenant du District de Pucallpa et de la ville d'Iquitos, ont été rapportés à Lima en décembre 1963.¹ Les recherches faites dans le Département de Loreto (bassin de l'Amazone) ont révélé des poussées d'une affection fébrile accompagnée d'éruption dans plusieurs localités des rives de l'Ucayali, du Yabari et de l'Amazone; dans certains cas, les manifestations cliniques étaient celles de la varicelle — dans d'autres, celles de la variole. Six cas de variole à San José de Omagua, Mazan et Shuashado (Rio Napo) ont été confirmés par le laboratoire au cours de la semaine terminée le 8 février. Des études épidémiologiques et sérologiques sont en cours.

Peru. — Two cases of smallpox, originating in Pucallpa District and in Iquitos, were reported in Lima in December 1963.¹ Investigations in the Department of Loreto (Amazon Basin) have revealed outbreaks of an eruptive and febrile syndrome — some cases corresponding clinically to chickenpox, others to smallpox — in several localities on the Ucayali, Yabari and Amazon Rivers. Six cases of smallpox in San José de Omagua, Mazan and Shuashado (Rio Napo) were confirmed by laboratory during the week ended 8 February. Epidemiological and serological studies are in progress.
