INFORMATIONS ÉPIDÉMIOLOGIQUES

CHOLÉRA

Asie

Iran. —¹ 1 243 cas² de choléra El Tor ont été rapportés en Iran pour la semaine terminée le 7 août, et 617 cas² pour la semaine terminée le 14 août.

Dans la Province de *Mazandaran*, située au nord, les circonscriptions infectées sont les Districts de Gonabad et de Gorgan, qui bordent la frontière de l'URSS à l'est de la Mer Caspienne.

Dans la Province de *Khorasan*, située au nord-est en bordure de l'URSS et de l'Afghanistan, les circonscriptions infectées sont les Districts de Mashhad, Torbat Heydarieh, Taiabad, Shirvan et Kashmar; la ville de Mashhad possède un aéroport.

Dans la Province de *Baluchestan et Sistan*, située au sud-est en bordure de l'Afghanistan et du Pakistan occidental, les circonscriptions infectées sont les Districts d'Iranshahr, Saravan et Chahbahar; ce dernier comprend le port de Chahbahar, situé sur le Golfe d'Oman.

Dans la Province de *Kerman*, située au sud de la Province de Khorasan et à l'ouest du Baluchestan, les circonscriptions infectées sont les Districts de Kerman et de Rafsenjan; la ville de Kerman possède un aéroport.

Par télégramme en date du 16 août, il a été confirmé qu'il n'y avait pas de cas de choléra en Iran en dehors des 4 provinces mentionnées ci-dessus.

Les mesures prévues par le Règlement sanitaire international doivent être limitées aux personnes provenant de circonscriptions infectées, exclusivement (voir article 61).

PESTE

Amérique

Etats-Unis. —¹ Le *County* de Navajo, en Arizona, a été déclaré circonscription infectée de peste des rongeurs sauvages le 5 août, la maladie ayant été confirmée par le test des anticorps fluorescents chez un cadavre de coyotte découvert à cette date. Prewitt, dans le *County* de McKinley (New Mexico), a été déclaré circonscription infectée de peste des rongeurs sauvages le 6 août (cadavre de coyotte infectée de peste trouvé à cette date). Cette dernière circonscription avait été à l'origine de l'infection d'un garçon indien de 9 ans hospitalisé à Gallup le 1er août; ¹ ce cas fut confirmé par le laboratoire le 12 août. Les deux circonscriptions infectées n'ont aucune importance au point de vue du trafic international.

Il est rappelé que l'Assemblée mondiale de la Santé a accepté la recommandation suivante du Comité de la Quarantaine internationale:

« Il n'y a normalement pas lieu de prendre des mesures à l'égard d'une circonscription notifiée comme infectée de peste des rongeurs sauvages, à moins que certains faits ne montrent que la peste des rongeurs sauvages s'est infiltrée ou tend à s'infiltrer chez les rongeurs domestiques, constituant ainsi une menace pour le trafic international; ces circonscriptions devraient toutefois être notifiées télégraphiquement à l'Organisation dans les vingt-quatre heures qui suivent le moment où elles ont été reconnues comme infectées. »²

EPIDEMIOLOGICAL NOTES

CHOLERA

Asia

Iran. —¹ 1 243 cases² of cholera El Tor were reported in Iran for the week ended 7 August and 617 cases² for the week ended 14 August.

In *Mazandaran* Province, situated in the north of the country, the infected local areas are the Districts of Gonabad and Gorgan which border USSR, east of the Caspian Sea.

In *Khorasan* Province, bordering USSR and Afghanistan in the north-east of Iran, the infected local areas are the Districts of Mashhad, Torbat Heydarieh, Taiabad, Shirvan and Kashmar; Mashhad town is served by an airport.

In *Baluchestan and Sistan* Province, bordering Afghanistan and West Pakistan in the south-east of Iran, the infected local areas are the Districts of Iranshahr, Saravan and Chahbahar; the latter includes the port of Chahbahar on the Gulf of Oman.

In *Kerman* Province, situated south of Khorasan Province and west of Baluchestan, the infected local areas are the Districts of Kerman and Rafsenjan; Kerman town is served by an airport.

Confirmation was received by a cable of 16 August that there was no cholera case in Iran outside the four above-mentioned provinces.

The measures provided for in the International Sanitary Regulations should be limited exclusively to arrivals from infected local areas (see Article 61).

PLAGUE

America

United States. —¹ Navajo County, in Arizona, was declared a local area infected with wild-rodent plague on 5 August; the disease was confirmed by fluorescent antibody test in a dead prairie dog (*cynomys*) found on that date. Prewitt in McKinley County (New Mexico) has been declared a local area infected with wild-rodent plague on 6 August (dead prairie dog (*cynomys*) found on that date). This latter local area was the source of infection for a nine-year-old Indian boy hospitalized in Gallup on 1st August;¹ laboratory confirmation of this case was obtained on 12 August. Neither of these two infected local areas is significant to international traffic.

It is recalled that the World Health Assembly has accepted the following recommendation of the Committee on International Quarantine:

“Measures need not normally be taken against a local area which has been notified as infected with wild-rodent plague, unless there is evidence that the wild-rodent plague has infiltrated or is tending to infiltrate into the domestic rodent population, and thus threatens international traffic; such areas should, however, be notified to the Organization by telegram within twenty-four hours of the recognition of the disease.”²

**CRITÈRES APPLIQUÉS POUR LA COMPILATION
DE LA LISTE DES TERRITOIRES INFECTÉS**

Conformément au Règlement sanitaire international (tel qu'il a été amendé par les Règlements additionnels de 1955, 1956 et 1963), les critères suivants sont appliqués pour la compilation et la mise à jour de la liste des territoires infectés:

- I. Un territoire ou une circonscription est porté sur la liste lorsque l'Organisation a reçu:
- i) une déclaration d'infection, aux termes de l'article 3;
 - ii) notification d'un premier cas de peste, de choléra, de fièvre jaune ou de variole qui n'est ni un cas importé ni un cas transféré;
 - iii) notification de l'existence de la peste parmi les rongeurs, à terre ou à bord d'engins flottants qui font partie d'une installation portuaire;
 - iv) notification de l'activité du virus amaril chez des vertébrés autres que l'homme, déterminée par l'application de l'un des critères suivants:
 - a) découverte des lésions spécifiques de la fièvre jaune dans le foie de vertébrés de la faune indigène du territoire ou de la circonscription; ou
 - b) isolement du virus de la fièvre jaune chez n'importe quel vertébré de la faune indigène;
 - v) notification d'une épidémie de typhus ou de fièvre récurrente [le terme épidémie s'entend de la présence d'au moins deux cas, qui ne sont ni des cas importés ni des cas transférés, dans une circonscription pendant une période de quatre semaines (typhus) ou de trois semaines (fièvre récurrente)].
- II. Les territoires ou circonscriptions sont radiés de la liste dans les conditions suivantes:
- i) si le territoire ou la circonscription a été déclaré infecté (article 3), il est radié de la liste lorsque l'Organisation reçoit une notification faite en application de l'article 6, suivant laquelle le territoire ou la circonscription est indemne d'infection. Si l'on dispose de renseignements indiquant que le territoire ou la circonscription n'a pas été indemne d'infection pendant une période correspondant à la durée indiquée dans l'article 6, la notification prévue par l'article 6 n'est pas publiée, le territoire ou la circonscription reste sur la liste et l'administration sanitaire intéressée est priée de donner des éclaircissements quant à la situation exacte;
 - ii) si le territoire ou la circonscription a été porté sur la liste pour des raisons autres que la réception de la notification prévue par l'article 3 (voir I. ii) à v) ci-dessus), il est radié de la liste lorsque des rapports hebdomadaires négatifs ont été reçus pendant une période dont la durée est indiquée à l'article 6. A défaut de tels rapports, le territoire ou la circonscription est radié de la liste lorsque, au terme de la période indiquée à l'article 6, l'Organisation reçoit une notification d'exemption d'infection (article 6).

**CRITERIA USED IN COMPILING THE INFECTED
AREA LIST**

Based on the International Sanitary Regulations (as amended by Additional Regulations of 1955, 1956 and 1963) the following criteria are used in compiling and maintaining the infected area list:

- I. An area is entered in the list on receipt of information of:
- (i) a declaration of infection under Article 3;
 - (ii) the first case of plague, cholera, yellow fever or smallpox that is neither an imported case nor a transferred case;
 - (iii) plague infection among rodents on land or on craft which are part of the equipment of a port;
 - (iv) activity of yellow-fever virus in vertebrates other than man using one of the following criteria:
 - (a) the discovery of the specific lesions of yellow fever in the liver of vertebrates indigenous to the area; or
 - (b) the isolation of yellow-fever virus from any indigenous vertebrates;
 - (v) an epidemic of typhus or relapsing fever [an epidemic is interpreted to mean the occurrence of two or more cases which are neither imported nor transferred cases in a local area during a four-week (typhus) or a three-week (relapsing fever) period].
- II. An area is deleted from the list on receipt of information as follows:
- (i) if the area was declared infected (Article 3), it is deleted from the list on receipt of a declaration under Article 6 that the area is free from infection. If information is available which indicates the area has not been free from infection during the time intervals stated in Article 6, the Article 6 declaration is not published, the area remains on the list and the health administration concerned is queried as to the true situation;
 - (ii) if the area entered the list for reasons other than a declaration under Article 3 (see I. (ii) to (v) above), it is deleted from the list on receipt of negative weekly reports for the time intervals stated in Article 6. In the absence of such reports, the area is deleted from the list on receipt of a notification of freedom from infection (Article 6) when at least the time period given in Article 6 has elapsed since the last notified case.
