Etats-Unis (Information au 20 février). —¹ La grippe continue à sévir dans le nord-est du pays et dans d'autres états dispersés. Les nouveaux états qui ont rapporté l'affection d'allure grippale pendant la semaine écoulée sont le Texas, la Floride, l'Ohio, le Wisconsin, l'Arkansas, le Tennessee et la Caroline du Nord.

La mortalité par pneumonie et grippe rapportée par 122 villes des Etats-Unis continue à manifester une légère hausse au-dessus du seuil épidémique. Alors que la mortalité par pneumonie et grippe rapportée dans les états de la Nouvelle-Angleterre montre une tendance à la baisse cette semaine, cette mortalité continue à augmenter dans les états du Centre Atlantique.

Le tableau suivant est un résumé de l'activité grippale ainsi que de l'activité des affections d'allure grippale pendant la saison 1964-1965.

United States (Information on 20 February). —¹ Influenza continues to occur in the Northeastern part of the country and in other scattered States. Additional States reporting influenza or influenza-like illness during the past week are Texas, Florida, Ohio, Wisconsin, Arkansas, Tennessee, and North Carolina.

Current pneumonia and influenza mortality reported by 122 US cities persists in showing a slight elevation above the epidemic threshold. While the pneumonia-influenza mortality in the New England States shows a downward trend this week, that in the Middle Atlantic Division of States continues to rise.

The following chart is a summary of influenza and influenza-like activity during the 1964-1965 season.

INFORMATIONS ÉPIDÉMIOLOGIQUES (suite)

GRIPPE (suite)

Centre mondial de la Grippe, Londres. —¹ Les résultats des tests de fixation du complément effectués avec des antisérums spécifiques, ainsi que ceux des tests d'inhibition de l'hémagglutination effectués sur deux souches 1965 reçues de Moscou ont été concordants et font penser que ces souches sont plus proches de A2/Singapore/1/57 que des variantes suivantes. Les premiers résultats des examens de deux autres souches, une de Moscou et une de Leningrad, ont montré que, malgré certaines différences avec les variantes récentes du virus A2 (1963 et 1964), elles se rapprochent plus de ces variantes récentes que des souches de 1957. Afin d'obtenir une meilleure idée de leurs affinités, un antisérum de furet est en préparation.

Europe

Danemark, Espagne,² Suisse³ et Tchécoslovaquie.³ — Au 23 février, aucune épidémie d'allure grippale n'avait été notifiée.

Autriche (Information au 2 mars). — Au cours des deux dernières semaines, on a observé une légère augmentation dans la fréquence des affections respiratoires bénignes. Aucun cas dû à un virus grippal n'a été confirmé.

France (Information au 23 février). — L'infection grippale à virus A a été identifiée par la sérologie dans des foyers épidémiques survenus à Guéret (département de la Creuse) et à Brive (Corrèze), ainsi que dans des cas survenus à Bourg-en-Bresse (Ain) et à Toulon (Var). Une épidémie d'allure grippale a également été rapportée à l'hospice de Niort (Deux-Sèvres).

Pays-Bas (Information au 2 mars). —⁴ Au cours des deux dernières semaines de février, le virus grippal B a été isolé chez un malade et l'infection à virus B a été mise en évidence par la sérologie chez trois autres malades. Le virus grippal A2 a été isolé chez un malade lors d'une épidémie bénigne d'allure grippale sur un bateau suédois ancré à Rotterdam. Il ne paraît pas y avoir d'épidémie dans la population civile.

Suède (Information au 26 février). —² Depuis le début de février, 800 à 1000 cas d'affections d'allure grippale ont été observés à Stockholm et dans le nord de la Suède où la maladie paraît déjà être sur son déclin. L'infection à virus grippal A a été mise en évidence par la sérologie dans quatre cas et un agent hémagglutinant, que les examens préliminaires font identifier comme un virus A2, a été isolé chez un malade arrivé récemment de Finlande. Pendant la dernière semaine, deux épidémies bénignes d'allure grippale ont été rapportées par des unités militaires à Stockholm et par une pension située dans le nord de la Suède. La maladie ne paraît pas se propager dans le pays pour le moment.

INFLUENZA (continued)

World Influenza Centre, London. —¹ The results of the strain specific complement fixation and hemagglutination inhibition tests with two 1965 strains received from Moscow are in fairly good agreement, suggesting that they are closer to A2/Singapore/1/57 than to subsequent variants. Preliminary results of the testing of another two strains, one from Moscow and one from Leningrad, have shown closer relation to the more recent A2 variants than to the 1957 strains, although some difference seems to exist between the newly isolated strains and the 1963 and 1964 variants. In order to have a better idea of their reciprocal relationships antisera are now being prepared in furets.

Europe

Czechoslovakia,² Spain,² Denmark and Switzerland.³ — No outbreaks of an influenza-like illness have been reported up to 23 February.

Austria (Information on 2 March). — A moderate rise in the frequency of mild respiratory illnesses has been observed during the last fortnight. No case of influenza virus has been confirmed.

France (Information on 23 February). — Serological evidence of infection with virus A has been obtained in epidemic foci in Guéret (Creuse department) and in Brive (Corrèze), as well as in cases in Bourg-en-Bresse (Ain) and in Toulon (Var). Influenza-like illness has also been reported at the Niort Hospice (Deux-Sèvres).

Netherlands (Information on 2 March). —⁴ In the second half of February, influenza B virus has been isolated from one patient and serological evidence of influenza B has been obtained in three others. Influenza A2 virus has been isolated from one patient in an outbreak of clinical influenza on a Swedish ship in Rotterdam. There is no evidence of epidemic influenza in the civilian population.

Sweden (Information on 26 February). —² Since the beginning of February between 800 and 1000 cases of influenza-like disease have been observed in Stockholm and northern Sweden where the incidence appears to be decreasing already. Serological evidence of influenza A has been obtained in four cases and a hemagglutinating agent, preliminary identified as influenza A2 virus, has been isolated from a patient recently arrived from Finland. During the last week two minor outbreaks of clinical influenza have been reported from military units in Stockholm and from a boarding school in northern Sweden. There is, as yet, no evidence of an epidemic spread of the disease.
