INFORMATIONS ÉPIDÉMIOLOGIQUES

VARIOLE

Asie

Birmanie (information en date du 13 avril). — Un cas de variole non importé a été notifié pour la semaine terminée le 9 avril dans la moitié nord de l'Etat de Shan, située dans l'est du pays.

Aucun cas de variole n'avait été rapporté en Birmanie depuis février 1965 (8 cas dans la Division de Tenasserim, au sud-est du pays). La source de l'infection n'est pas encore connue.

GRIPPE

Amérique

Etats-Unis d'Amérique (information en date du 9 avril). —¹ Pendant la semaine écoulée, plusieurs nouveaux états ont rapporté des poussées avec mise en évidence de l'infection à virus grippal. Au cours des poussées survenues en Arizona et en Montana, l'infection à virus A a été mise en évidence par les examens sérologiques. En Nebraska, le virus grippal B a été isolé au cours d'une épidémie survenue dans une région rurale; plusieurs souches de virus B ont également été isolées à Omaha dans des cas sporadiques. En Californie, où une importante épidémie à virus A2 est survenue cette année, plusieurs souches de virus B ont été isolées simultanément dans la région de San Francisco, sans aucune association avec les épidémies à virus B survenues par ailleurs. En ce qui concerne l'affection d'allure grippale observée dans l'est du Tennessee, l'infection à virus B a maintenant été mise en évidence par les examens sérologiques.

Les notifications de mortalité par pneumonie et grippe en provenance de 122 villes des Etats-Unis montrent que la mortalité excessive continue à diminuer, tout en restant encore au-dessus du seuil épidémique. Cette constatation est en corrélation avec le déclin de la mortalité dans les Divisions « des Montagnes » et « du Pacifique » (qui, seules, contribuèrent à la mortalité excessive observée précédemment).

Europe

République fédérale d'Allemagne (information en date du 7 avril). — Une augmentation de l'incidence des affections d'allure grippale semble se manifester actuellement dans la Région de la Hesse, principalement chez les adultes. Des infections récentes à virus grippaux A et B ont été mises en évidence par les examens sérologiques.

EPIDEMIOLOGICAL NOTES

SMALLPOX

Asia

Burma (information dated 13 April). — One non-imported case of smallpox has been notified for the week ended 9 April in the northern half of Shan State, located in the east of the country. No case of smallpox had been reported in Burma since February 1965 (8 cases in the Tenasserim Division, located in the south-east of the country). The source of infection is not yet known.

INFLUENZA

America

United States of America (information dated 9 April). —¹ During the past week, several additional states have reported outbreaks with evidence of infection with influenza virus. In outbreaks in Arizona and Montana, serological evidence of infection with Virus A has been obtained. In Nebraska, influenza Virus B was isolated in an epidemic which occurred in a rural area; several strains of influenza Virus B were also isolated from sporadic cases in Omaha. In California, where a major A2 outbreak has been occurring this year, there have been several isolates of type B Virus made simultaneously in the San Francisco area; they are not associated with outbreaks with Virus B which occurred otherwise. As regards the influenza-like illness which occurred in Eastern Tennessee, serological evidence of infection with Virus B has now been obtained.

Excess mortality due to influenza and pneumonia in 122 United States cities continues to decline, although still remaining above the epidemic threshold. Correlating with this is the decline in mortality in the Mountain and Pacific Divisions (which were the only ones contributing to the excess mortality previously observed).

Europe

Federal Republic of Germany (information dated 7 April). — Some evidence of an increased incidence of influenza-like illness has been reported from the Region of Hesse, principally in adults. Serological evidence of recent infections with influenza Viruses A and B has been obtained.
