Afrique

Côte française des Somalis. —¹ Pendant la semaine terminée le 12 février, 18 nouveaux cas de variole, dont 4 décès, ont été rapportés dans le Cercle de Dikhil. Un de ces cas a été importé de la province de Harar (Ethiopie) de même que les deux cas importés rapportés précédemment.⁴

GRIPPE

Amérique

Etats-Unis d'Amérique: Massachusetts. —² Deux souches de virus grippal B ont été isolées chez des malades au cours des épidémies d'allure grippale qui ont déjà été rapportées dans l'est du *Massachusetts*.² En outre, l'infection à virus B a été mise en évidence par les examens sérologiques couplés de 3 autres malades.

Asie

Japon (information en date du 3 février). — Depuis fin décembre 1965, des poussées épidémiques d'affections des voies respiratoires supérieures ont été rapportées dans plusieurs écoles élémentaires et intermédiaires de la préfecture de Tokyo et de cinq autres préfectures situées à l'ouest et au sud-ouest de Tokyo. Une souche de virus grippal B a été isolée dans la préfecture de Gifu.

Europe

Pays-Bas (information en date du 14 février). — Une incidence légèrement accrue des affections d'allure grippale est signalée dans toutes les régions du pays. Le virus grippal A2 a été isolé chez quelques malades et l'infection à virus B a été mise en évidence par les examens sérologiques chez un jeune adulte (cas mortel compliqué de pneumonie à staphylocoques).³

Roumanie (information en date du 7 février). —¹ Depuis la fin du mois de janvier, des poussées d'affections d'allure grippale ont été notifiées dans plusieurs régions de Roumanie, en particulier dans le nord-ouest. L'affection est généralement bénigne; elle affecte principalement les enfants d'âge scolaire. Plusieurs souches de virus grippal B ont été isolées, et l'infection à virus B a été mise en évidence en divers endroits par les examens sérologiques.

Royaume-Uni: Angleterre et Galles (information en date du 5 février). —² Des poussées épidémiques sont toujours rapportées dans les écoles, mais la grippe atteint maintenant les adultes aussi bien que les écoliers — en particulier dans le nord du pays. Le virus B a de nouveau été isolé chez des écoliers. Le virus A2 a été isolé chez quelques malades adultes et chez des malades hospitalisés dans des salles de vieillards.

La souche A2/England/1/66 a été testée au *Centre mondial de la Grippe de Londres*. Elle est très proche des variantes A2 de 1964 et 1965; elle diffère des souches antérieures, malgré la persistance d'affinités antigéniques.

EPIDEMIOLOGICAL NOTES

SMALLPOX

Africa

French Somaliland. —¹ During week ended 12 February, 18 additional smallpox cases, including 4 deaths, were reported in Dikhil Circle. One of these cases was imported from Harar Province, Ethiopia as well as two previously reported imported cases.⁴

INFLUENZA

America

United States of America: Massachusetts. —² Two strains of influenza Virus B were isolated from patients during the influenza-like outbreaks which have already been reported in eastern *Massachusetts*.² Evidence of infection with Virus B was also obtained by serological tests of paired sera in three additional instances.

Asia

Japan (Information on 3 February). — Since the end of December 1965, outbreaks of upper respiratory tract illness have been reported in several elementary and middle schools in Tokyo Prefecture and in five other prefectures located west and south-west of Tokyo. A strain of influenza Virus B was isolated in Gifu Prefecture.

Europe

Netherlands (information dated 14 February). — A slightly increased incidence of influenza-like disease is reported throughout the country. Influenza Virus A2 has been isolated from a few patients and serological evidence of infection with Virus B was obtained in a young adult (fatal case complicated by staphylococcal pneumonia).³

Romania (information dated 7 February). —¹ Since the end of January, outbreaks of influenza-like illness have been notified in several regions of Romania, particularly in the north-west. The disease is generally mild, affecting principally children of school age. Several strains of influenza Virus B were isolated, and serological evidence of infection with Virus B was obtained in various localities.

United Kingdom: England and Wales (information dated 5 February). —² Outbreaks in schools continue to be reported but adults as well as school children are now involved, especially in northern areas of the country. There have been further isolations of influenza Virus B from school children. Influenza Virus A2 has been isolated from some adult patients and from patients in geriatric wards.

The A2/England/1/66 strain, tested at the *World Influenza Centre, London*, is very close to the 1964 and 1965 A2 variants, and different from the earlier strains (though still related to them).

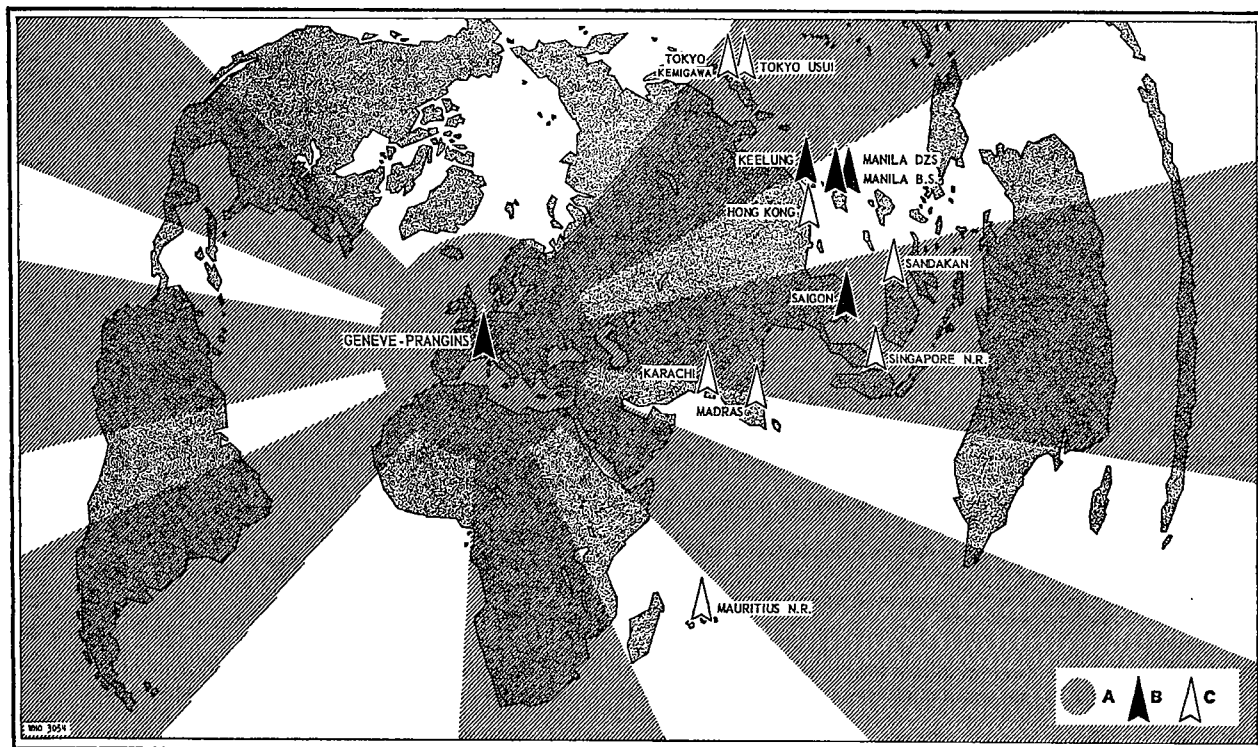
